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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 16458, COG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation in the 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 15

and the E/2E/2 of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the proposed **Huckleberry State Com No. 501H Well**, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 27 to bottom hole location in the NE/4NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 15.

In Case No. 16459, COG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation in the 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2E/2 of Section 15 and the W/2E/2 of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the two initial wells: the proposed **Huckleberry State Com No. 502H Well** and the proposed **Huckleberry State Com No. 503H Well**. Both wells will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 27 to bottom hole location in the NW/4NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 15.

In Case No. 16460, COG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation in the 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2W/2 of Section 15 and the E/2W/2 of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the two initial wells: the proposed **Huckleberry State Com No. 504H Well** and the proposed **Huckleberry State Com No. 505H Well**. Both wells will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 27 to bottom hole location in the NE/4NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 15.

In Case No. 16461, COG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation in the 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2W/2 of Section 15 and the W/2W/2 of Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the two initial wells: the proposed **Huckleberry State Com No. 506H Well** and the

proposed **Huckleberry State Com No. 507H Well**. Both wells will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 27 to bottom hole location in the NW/4NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 15.

The completed interval for all wells will remain within the standard setback as required by the Statewide rules for oil wells.
