APPLICATION OF CAZA PETROLEUM, LLC TO RE-OPEN CASE NO. 16360 FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

Case No. 16360 (Re-opened)

APPLICATION

Caza Petroleum, LLC applies for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the N/2 of Section 22 and the N/2 of Section 21, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the N/2 of Section 22 and the N/2 of Section 21, and has the right to drill a well or wells thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the following wells to a depth sufficient to test the Wolfcamp formation (Purple Sage-Wolfcamp Gas Pool):
 - (a) The Forehand Ranch 22-21 State Well No. 2H; and
 - (b) The Forehand Ranch 22-21 State Well No. 4H.

The wells are horizontal wells with surface locations in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 22 and last take points in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 21. Applicant seeks to dedicate the wells to the N/2 of Section 22 and the N/2 of Section 21 to form a 640 acre horizontal spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation.

- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the N/2 of Section 22 and the N/2 of Section 21 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the wells or to otherwise commit their interests to the wells, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests.

Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the N/2 of Section 22 and the N/2 of Section 21 pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. Pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the N/2 of Section 22 and the N/2 of Section 21 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the N/2 of Section 22 and the N/2 of Section 21;
- B. Designating Caza Operating, LLC as operator of the wells;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the wells, and allocating the cost among the wells' working interest owners;
- F. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the wells.
