## **APPLICANT:**

In Case No. 16415, Marathon seeks an order from the Division: pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit underlying the S/2 of Sections 7 and 8, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the **Fremen 7 WD Fed Com 1H** well, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for this well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well, and allowing a one year period between when the well is drilled and when the well is completed.

Said area is located approximately Nine (9) miles West of Malaga, New Mexico.
