- 2 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. With that, we'll
- 3 go ahead and start with the first case on the list,
- 4 which is Case Number 20252. The Applicant is Mewbourne
- 5 Oil Company, and this is for compulsory pooling. This
- 6 is Steelhead 17/20 B2J0 State Com #1H.
- 7 Mr. Bruce, when you're ready, we can go
- 8 ahead and start on this case.
- 9 MR. McMILLAN: Also, Mr. Examiner, Seth
- 10 McMillan on behalf of Devon Energy Company. I'm just
- 11 sitting in.
- 12 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay.
- This regards the application of Mewbourne
- 14 for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico.
- MR. BRUCE: Yeah. Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce
- of Santa Fe for the Applicant. I'm submitting this case
- 17 by affidavit.
- 18 Exhibit A is the affidavit of the landman,
- 19 Adriana Salgado, and it contains the usual land plat
- 20 showing the mile-and-a-half-well unit. It contains a
- 21 C-102 for the well. The well's name is the Steelhead
- 22 17/20 B2JO State Com Well #1H. If you look at the
- 23 C-102, it contains the old well name, the Osudo well,
- 24 but it has been changed.
- 25 Exhibit 2 shows the four interest owners

- 1 being force pooled, total of about 19 percent.
- 2 Exhibit 3 contains a summary of contacts of
- 3 the interest owners.
- 4 And Exhibit 4 is the AFE for the well.
- 5 It's \$8.8 million, which is stated to be fair and
- 6 reasonable. The overhead rates requested are 8,000 and
- 7 800 a month, and Mewbourne has the right to pool the
- 8 overriding royalty interest owners rights in the well.
- 9 Exhibit B is my Affidavit of Notice showing
- 10 parties being force pooled.
- 11 Three of the parties returned green cards.
- 12 Wilson Oil Company did not. Actually, I haven't gotten
- 13 the green card or the envelope back. But I did publish
- 14 notice, which is shown in Exhibit C against all the
- 15 parties, so all parties received actual or constructive
- 16 notice.
- 17 Exhibit D is an affidavit of Jordan
- 18 Carrell, the geologist, who discusses the Bone Spring
- 19 geology. The target is the 2nd Bone Spring, and you'll
- 20 see there is a structure map and isopach and a cross
- 21 section which gives the target zone in the Lower 2nd
- 22 Bone Spring Sand.
- 23 There is also attached to the geologist's
- 24 affidavit -- this is not -- this is not an area that has
- 25 a lot of production, but there are some recent 2nd Bone

1 Spring wells in the area, which show that some of them

- 2 are very productive. And both the landman and the
- 3 geologist state that the granting of this application is
- 4 in the interest of conservation and the prevention of
- 5 waste.
- 6 And I would move the admission of Exhibits
- 7 A through D and ask that the matter be taken under
- 8 advisement.
- 9 EXAMINER DAWSON: Any objection?
- MR. McMILLAN: No.
- 11 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. At this point
- 12 Exhibits A through D will be admitted to the record.
- 13 (Mewbourne Oil Company Exhibit Letters A
- 14 through D are offered and admitted into
- 15 evidence.)
- 16 EXAMINER DAWSON: Do you have any
- 17 questions, David?
- 18 EXAMINER BROOKS: No. I can't think of
- 19 any. I guess I'll ask my usual one because I don't
- 20 remember you commenting. Are there any overrides?
- MR. BRUCE: There are. Mewbourne has the
- 22 right to force pool them -- or pool them voluntarily.
- 23 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. Thank you.
- 24 EXAMINER DAWSON: Do you have any
- 25 questions?

EXAMINER WARNELL: No, sir.

EXAMINER MURPHY: No, sir.

EXAMINER DAWSON: There were no unlocatable

5 MR. BRUCE: No, no unlocatable. We just

6 didn't get a green card back from Wilson Oil Company.

7 And the address on the affidavit, I've mailed letters to

8 that address before and I've gotten back green cards.

9 Wilson Oil Company actually started in Santa Fe decades

10 ago, so I know they're locatable.

11 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay.

Mr. McMillan, do you have any questions?

MR. McMILLAN: I do not.

16 MR. BRUCE: I'd ask that the case be taken
