- 5 application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division
- 6 Compliance and Enforcement Bureau for a compliance order
- 7 against Ruth Oil Company, LLC for wells operated in Eddy
- 8 and Lea Counties, New Mexico.
- 9 Call for appearances.
- 10 MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, Keith
- 11 Herrmann, representing the Oil Conversation Division
- 12 Compliance and Enforcement Bureau.
- 13 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Is this case going to
- 14 be combined?
- MR. HERRMANN: No.
- 16 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Okay.
- 17 MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, this case is
- 18 unopposed. I submitted -- well, let me backtrack.
- 19 This is for a compliance order to return
- 20 five wells to compliance with 19.15.5.9.(A)(4) and 25.8
- 21 regarding inactive wells.
- 22 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Are there any other
- 23 appearances?
- 24 Please proceed.
- MR. HERRMANN: This is regarding the

1 operator, Ruth Oil & Gas. They have five wells in Lea

- 2 County. We have been in contact with this operator, and
- 3 I reflected that in the amended prehearing statement
- 4 that I filed yesterday. We had agreed with that
- 5 operator that they would return to compliance by June
- 6 15th.
- 7 So at this time, we request -- we're
- 8 requesting an order directing that operator to be in
- 9 compliance with the rule stated by June 15th, and in
- 10 support of that, I'm presenting you with our exhibits:
- 11 Exhibit 1, an inactive well list that identifies all the
- 12 wells; Exhibit 2, a Financial Assurance Report showing
- 13 what wells have bonds on them; Exhibit 3, a Notice of
- 14 Violation that we sent to the operator at least 60 days
- 15 prior to commencing this action. Exhibit 4 is an
- 16 affidavit from Mr. Daniel Sanchez, our Compliance and
- 17 Enforcement manager showing -- stating that those wells
- 18 have not had production reported in excess of 15 months;
- 19 and Exhibit 5 showing that we have provided notice to
- 20 the operator at both the addresses on file with the
- 21 Division, the addresses on file with the Secretary of
- 22 State and the bank that holds their financial assurance.
- 23 At this time I would move to admit OCD
- 24 Exhibits 1 through 5.
- 25 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Exhibits 1 through 5

- 1 may now be accepted as part of the record.
- 2 (NMOCD Compliance and Enforcement Bureau
- 3 Exhibit Numbers 1 through 5 are offered and
- 4 admitted into evidence.)
- 5 EXAMINER McMILLAN: And the question there
- 6 being: What do these unlocatables represent, pages 9
- 7 and 10? Did you run a newspaper ad on it?
- 8 MR. HERRMANN: No. We have had direct
- 9 contact with Robert Stratton, though, who is on the
- 10 first page, and he did receive the letters.
- 11 EXAMINER McMILLAN: And direct contact
- 12 being?
- MR. HERRMANN: Several telephone calls and
- 14 conversations, which is why we submitted that amended
- 15 prehearing statement to reflect the conversations.
- 16 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Emails?
- MR. HERRMANN: No emails.
- 18 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Just conversations?
- MR. HERRMANN: Yes.
- 20 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Okay.
- MR. HERRMANN: At this time we request that
- 22 this case be taken under advisement.
- 23 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Case Number 20197 shall
- 24 be taken under advisement.
- MR. HERRMANN: Thank you.
