The No. 502H well was spud on February 16, 2019. The No. 503H well has yet to spud.

The wells could not be completed due to scheduling issues. Accordingly, you are requesting a new completion date of December 30, 2019 to replace the existing time limit.

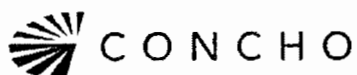

Dear Ms. Sandoval:

The above-referenced Division Orders granted COG Operating LLC's applications for compulsory pooling on November 13th, 2018. The orders authorized the drilling of COG's Huckleberry State Com Well Nos. 501H-507H at locations in Section 22 and Section 15, Township 21 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico. Copies of the orders are attached for your convenience.

Ordering Paragraph 6 of each order requires COG to drill and complete the well within 120 days or the order will terminate unless COG obtains a time extension from the Division Director for good cause shown. COG is pad drilling and completing these wells. COG is currently drilling the wells and believes it will release the drilling rigs in late May or early June 2019. Due to scheduling issues, completion operations will begin in mid-October and Concho estimates completion operations to be concluded in late November or early December 2019. Accordingly, COG respectfully requests until December 30, 2019 to complete the wells.
