- 2 EXAMINER LOWE: We will call Case Number
- 3 20330, Mewbourne Oil Company for compulsory pooling,
- 4 Eddy County.
- 5 Call for appearances.
- 6 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of
- 7 Santa Fe representing the Applicant. I have no
- 8 witnesses. I'll be presenting the case by affidavit.
- 9 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, Michael
- 10 Feldewert, with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart,
- 11 appearing on behalf of EOG Resources, Inc. We do not
- 12 object to this case moving forward by way of affidavit.
- MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I've handed you
- 14 several exhibits. The first one is the affidavit of
- 15 Tyler Jolly, a landman for Mewbourne in this case. They
- 16 are seeking to force pool the north half-southeast
- 17 quarter of Section 29 and the north half-south half of
- 18 Section 28 of 18-29 to drill a 2nd Bone Spring well, the
- 19 Pavo Frio 29/28 B2JI Federal Com Well #1H. There
- 20 attachments to the affidavit.
- 21 Attachment A is simply a Midland Map
- 22 Company plat showing the well unit and the well pathway.
- 23 Part of Attachment A is the C-102 for the wells. An APD
- 24 has not been issued yet, so the API number is still
- 25 pending.

1 Attachment B shows the interest ownership

- 2 the parties being pooled. The parties being pooled are
- 3 EOG Resources Assets, LLC -- and Mewbourne has been in
- 4 discussions with them. They expect them to eventually
- 5 be dismissed from the case because they probably will
- 6 reach terms, but they haven't as of yet -- and then
- 7 Patricia Ann Conley and Donna Bliven. The total
- 8 interest being pooled is about .7 percent.
- 9 Attachment C contains a summary of
- 10 communications between Mewbourne and the parties being
- 11 pooled, as well as proposal letters.
- 12 And then Attachment D is the estimated well
- 13 costs, which in this case is a little over \$7 million.
- 14 The well costs are stated to be fair and reasonable.
- 15 Mewbourne is seeking 8,000 and 800 -- 8,000 a month for
- 16 a drilling well and 800 a month for a producing well,
- 17 and those are typical rates that Mewbourne uses for
- 18 these wells in these cases. Mewbourne has the right to
- 19 pool any overriding royalty owners in the well unit.
- The affidavit does contain some stuff about
- 21 what they did to locate the people. Originally,
- 22 Mewbourne had trouble contacting Donna Bliven, but as
- 23 you'll see by Exhibit 2, my Affidavit of Notice, all the
- 24 parties being pooled did receive actual notice, even
- 25 Ms. Bliven. There were originally more parties being

1 pooled, but Mewbourne has worked out deals with five of

- 2 the parties who were initially pooled.
- 3 Exhibit 3 is an Affidavit of Publication.
- 4 Notice was published in the Carlsbad newspaper just in
- 5 case there were green cards not returned, which turned
- 6 out to be unnecessary.
- 7 And Exhibit 4 is the affidavit of Charles
- 8 Crosby, the geologist. It contains the usual maps, the
- 9 structure map, which also shows other Bone Spring
- 10 development in this area. Most of the Bone Spring wells
- in this particular area are drilled in lay-down units.
- 12 Attachment B is an isopach showing the
- 13 various thicknesses. The thickness is pretty uniform
- 14 across the well unit.
- 15 Attachment C is a cross section. It is
- 16 pretty small. It's kind of hard to read, but it does
- 17 indicate down at the bottom the target zone. If you
- 18 would like me to email you a copy of this cross section
- 19 that you can manipulate and look at bigger, I'll do so.
- 20 EXAMINER LOWE: Yeah.
- 21 MR. BRUCE: And then Attachment D is a
- 22 listing of wells and production from 2nd Bone Spring --
- 23 Lower 2nd Bone Spring wells in the area. And you can
- 24 see that virtually -- there are two older wells that are
- 25 stand-ups. The rest are all lay-downs and have some

- 1 pretty decent production even for the newer wells.
- 2 And Exhibit E is the Well Planning Report
- 3 showing the wellbore path, and the well location is
- 4 orthodox.
- 5 And with that, I move the admission of
- 6 Exhibits 1 through 4 and ask that the case be taken
- 7 under advisement.
- 8 EXAMINER LOWE: Any objection?
- 9 MR. FELDEWERT: No objection.
- 10 EXAMINER LOWE: Exhibits 1 through 4 will
- 11 be accepted in this case.
- 12 (Mewbourne Oil Company Exhibit Numbers 1
- through 4 are offered and admitted into
- 14 evidence.)
- 15 EXAMINER LOWE: Mr. Brooks, do you have any
- 16 questions?
- 17 EXAMINER BROOKS: No. I just looked at
- 18 this C-102. And I overlooked this bottom-hole location
- 19 is sneaking in there along the east line, and I thought,
- 20 well, don't mean to tell me we're having a vertical
- 21 well, but I found I was wrong.
- Thank you.
- 23 (Cell phone ringing.)
- 24 EXAMINER LOWE: I don't have any questions.
- Thank you.

Page 7 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Is the pool statewide? 1 MR. BRUCE: Yes. Yes. Yeah. The east 2 Palmilla is on statewide rules. 3 EXAMINER McMILLAN: Hey, and, you know, 4 5 apparently Mewbourne actually listened (indicating). 6 MR. BRUCE: That's the first thing I looked 7 for when I got that. 8 EXAMINER McMILLAN: So you'll have to tell 9 them. They didn't use monotone. 10 (Laughter.) 11 MR. BRUCE: I was worried about that when I 12 was clicking on it, whether it was going to pull up a 13 multicolored exhibit. 14 (Laughter.) EXAMINER McMILLAN: I'm fine. 15 16 EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. 17 MR. BRUCE: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. 18 EXAMINER LOWE: Case Number 20330 will be 19 taken under advisement. 20 It appears that concludes our hearing for today, unless there was anything else I forgot. 21 (Case Number 20330 concludes, 10:41 a.m.) 22 23 24 25
