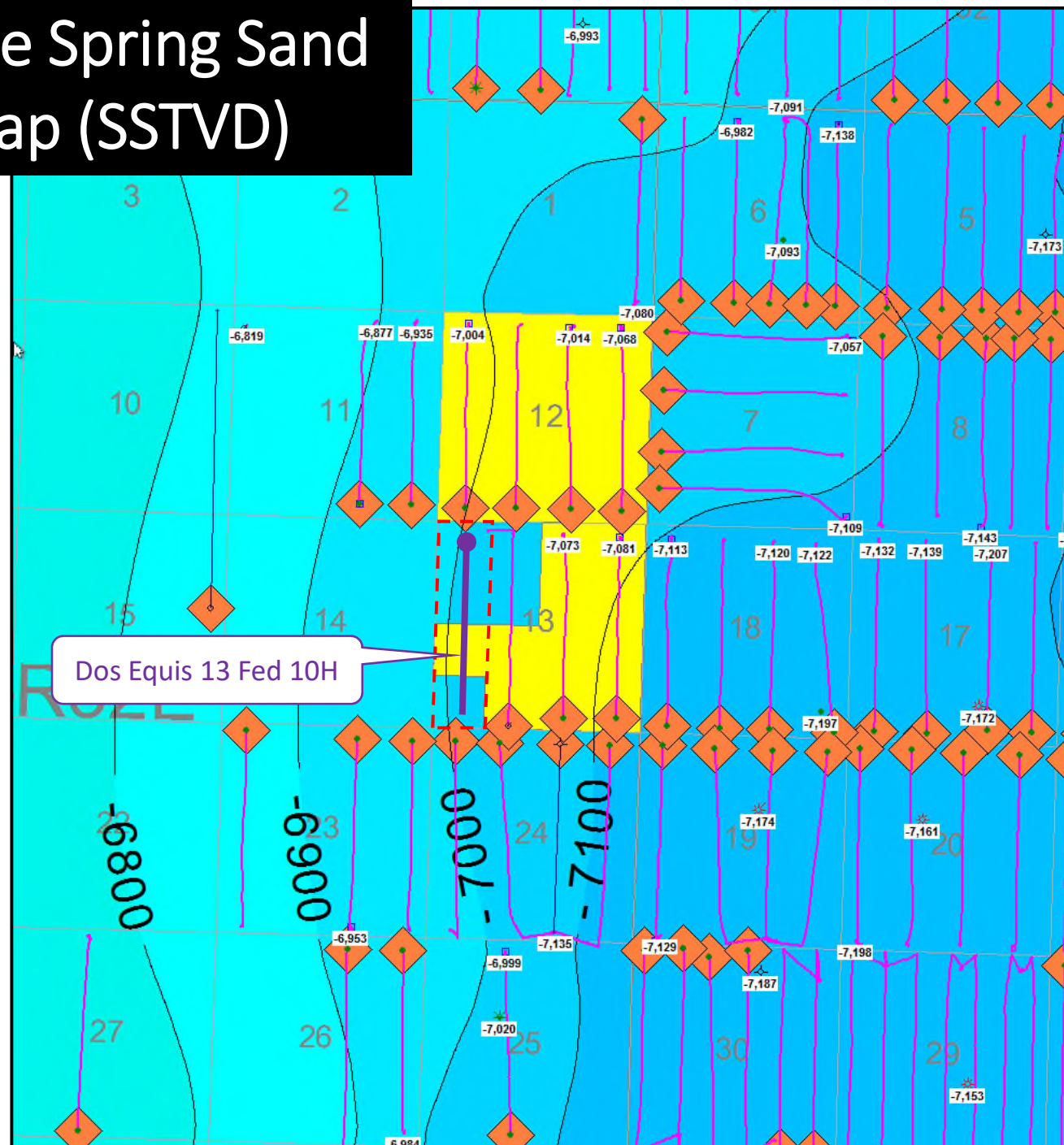

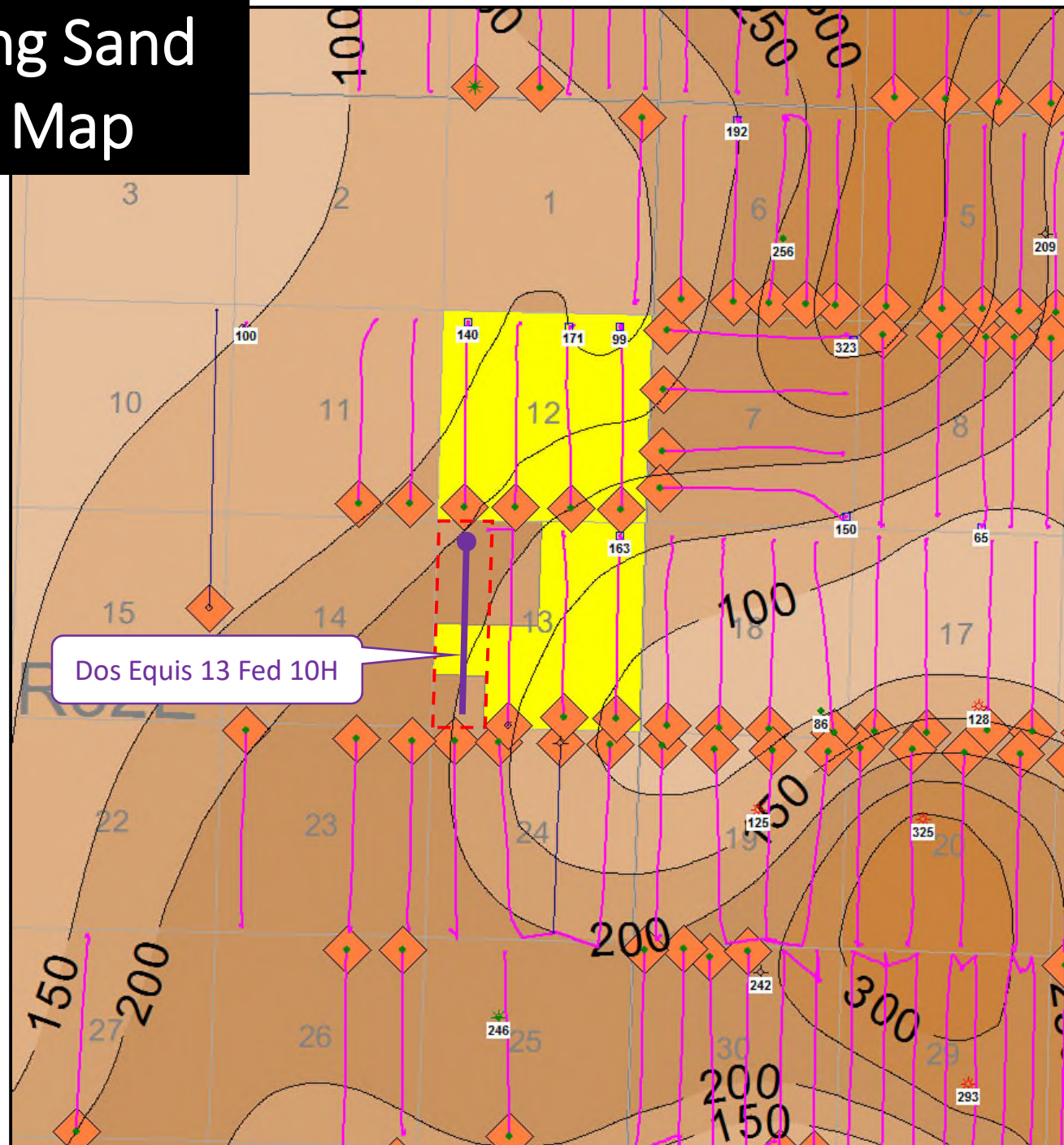

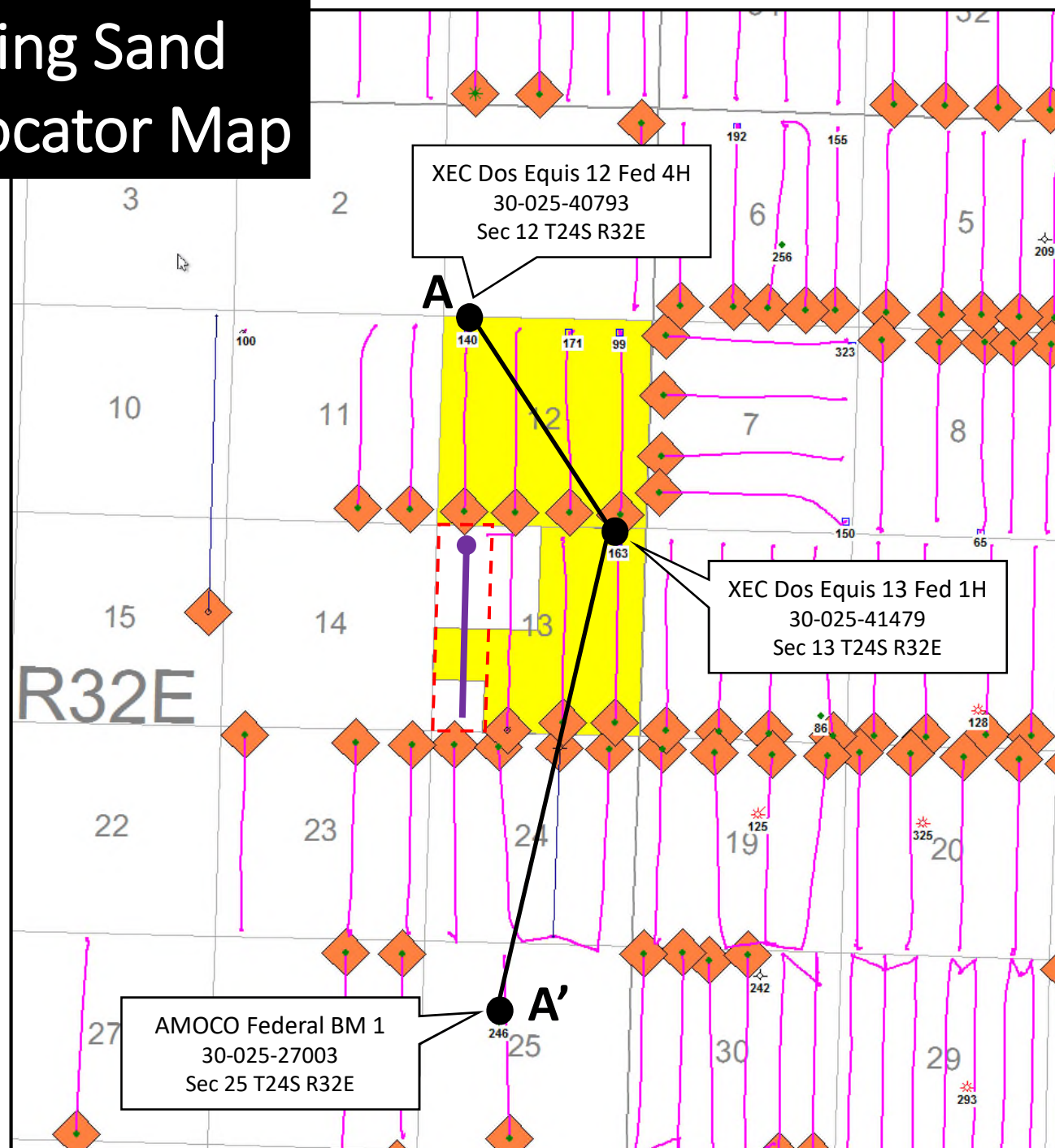

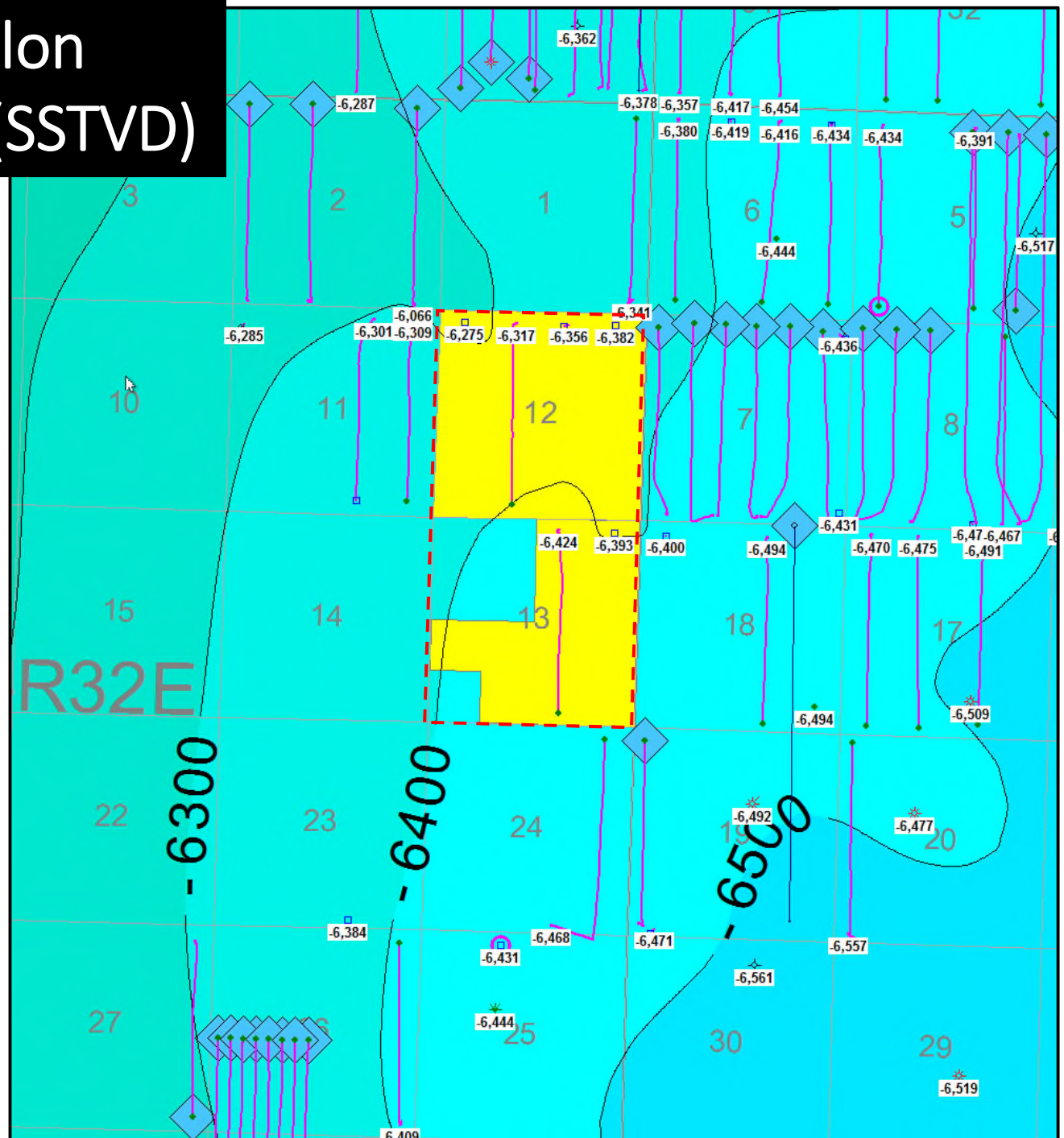

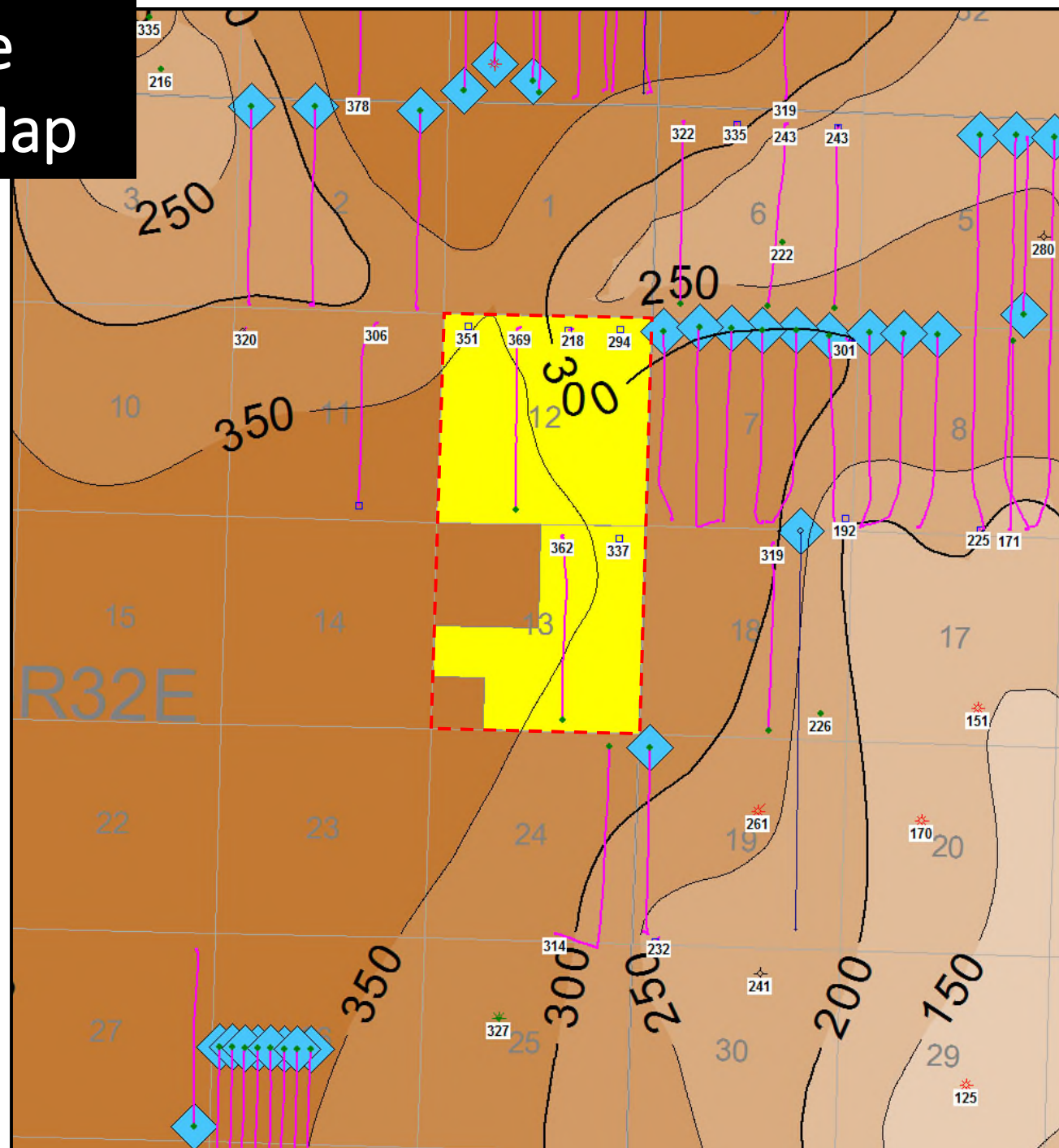

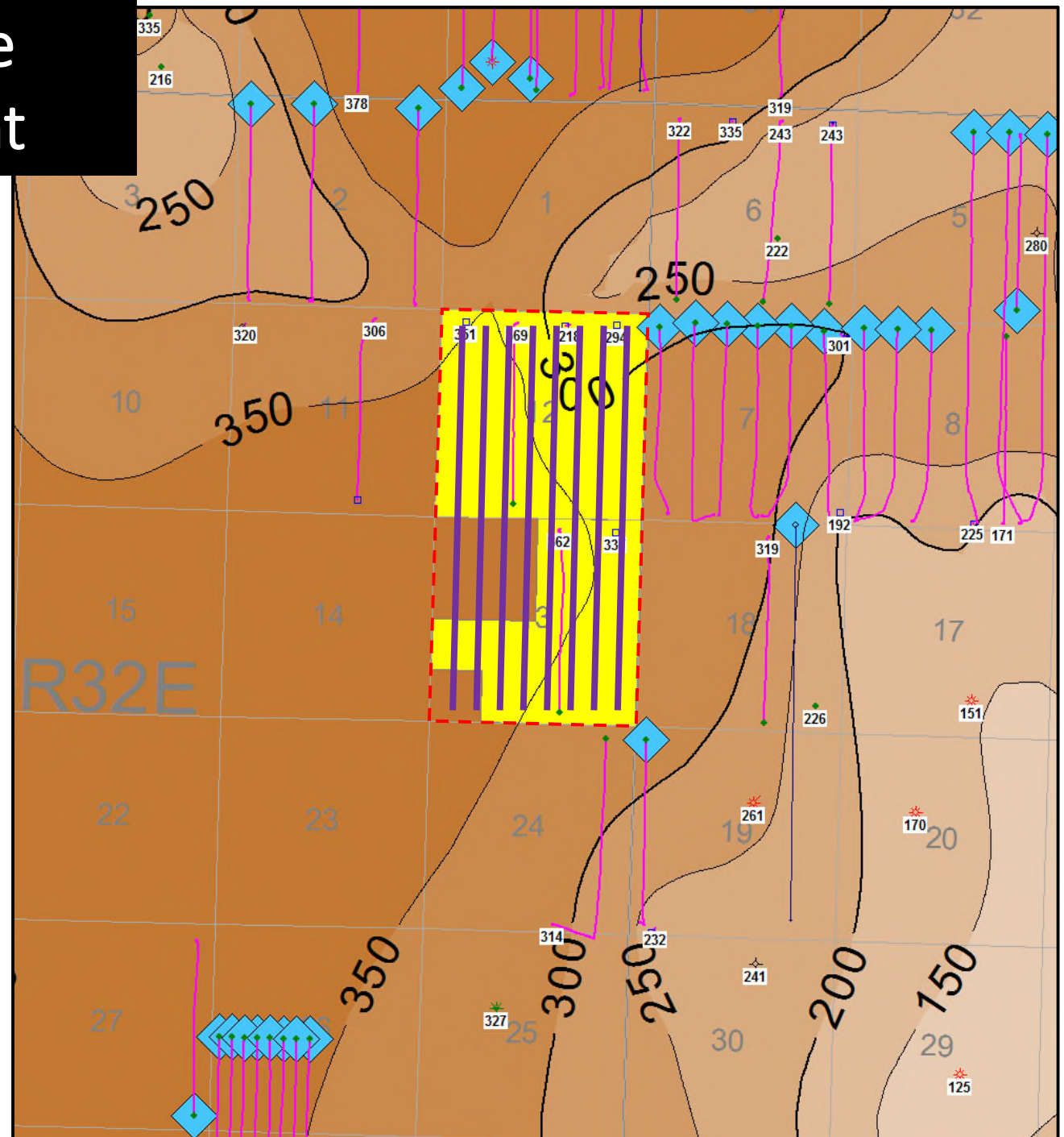

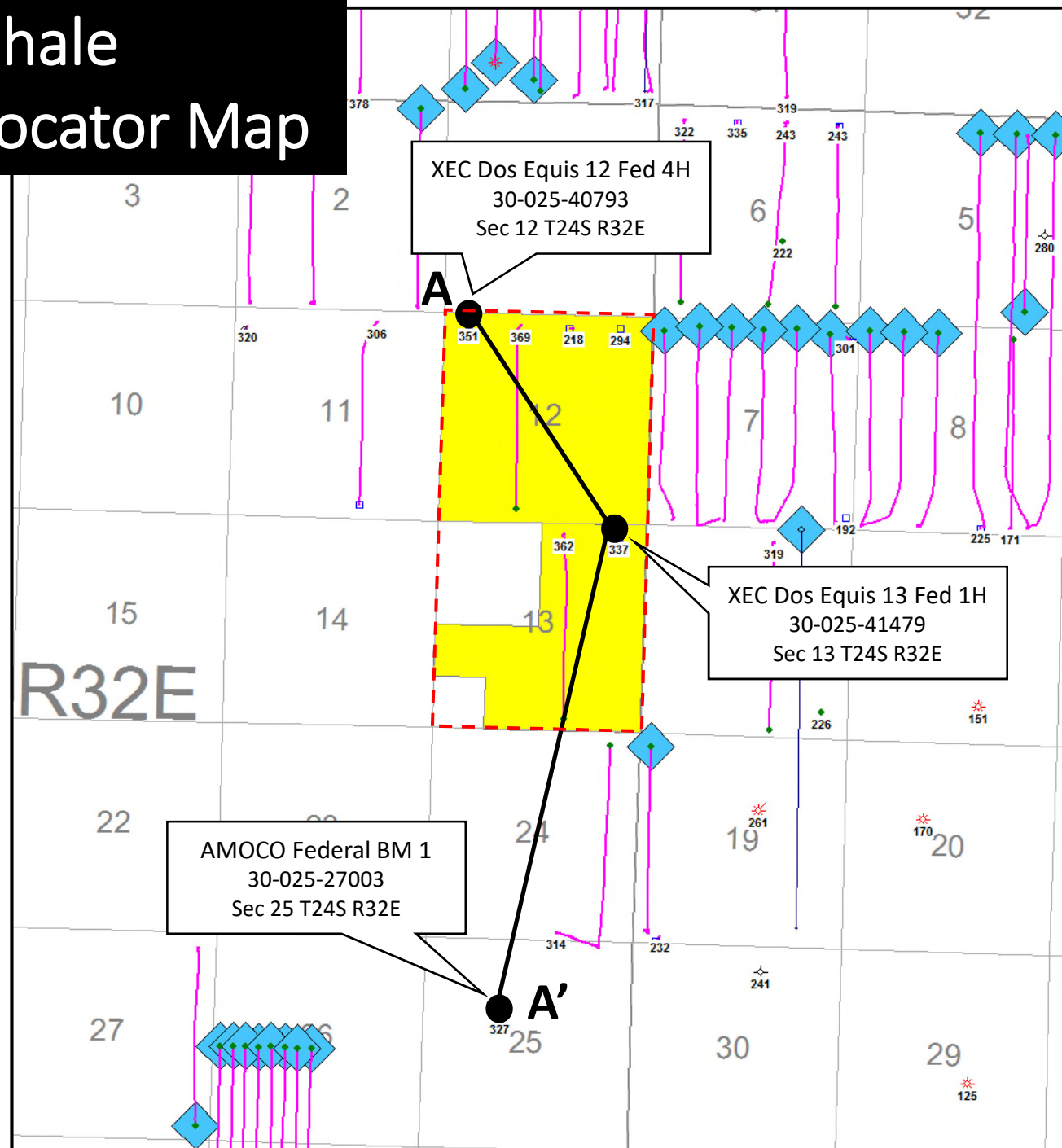

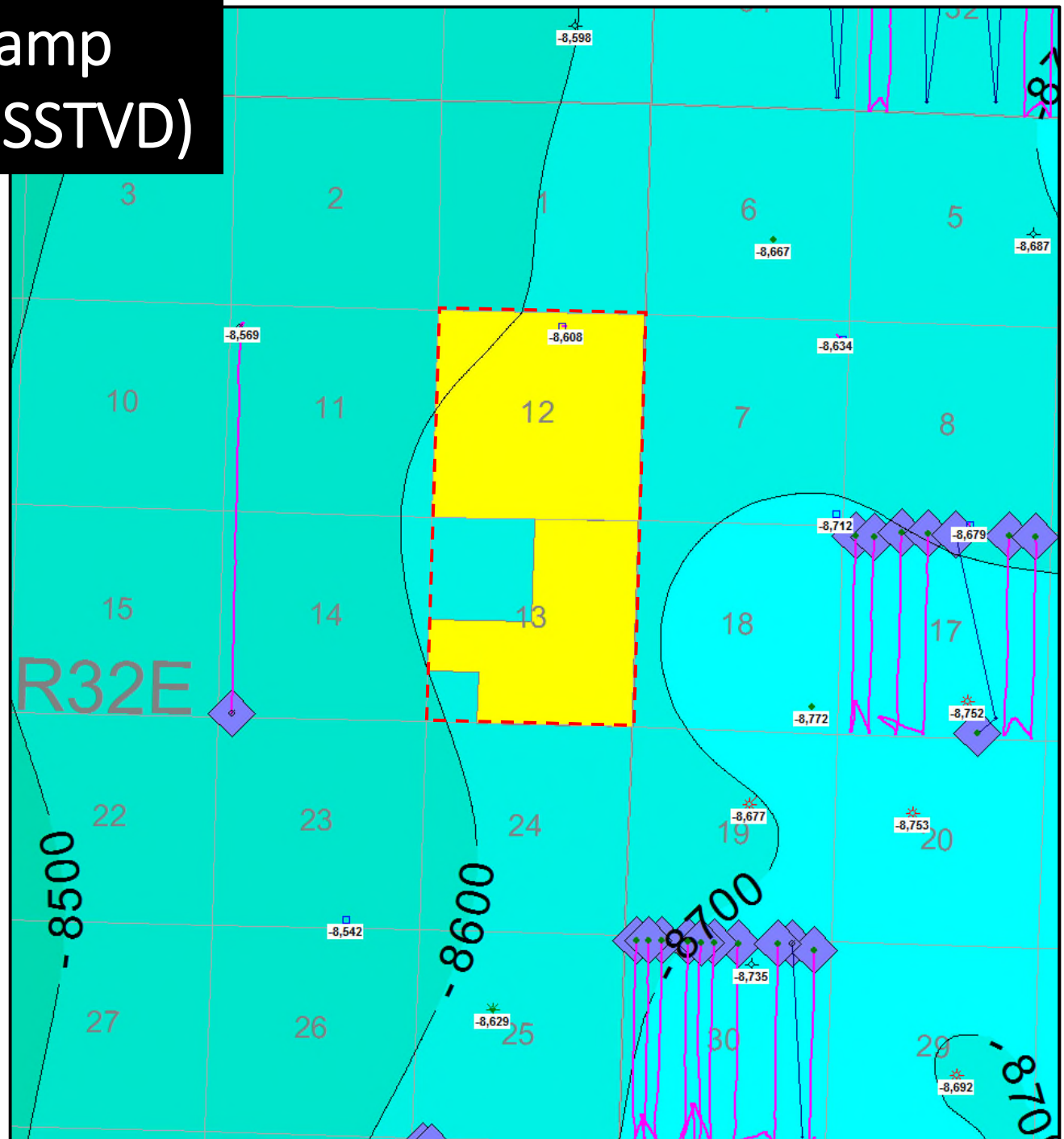

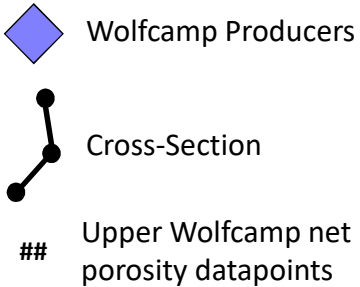
Top of Wolfcamp Structure Map (SSTVD)

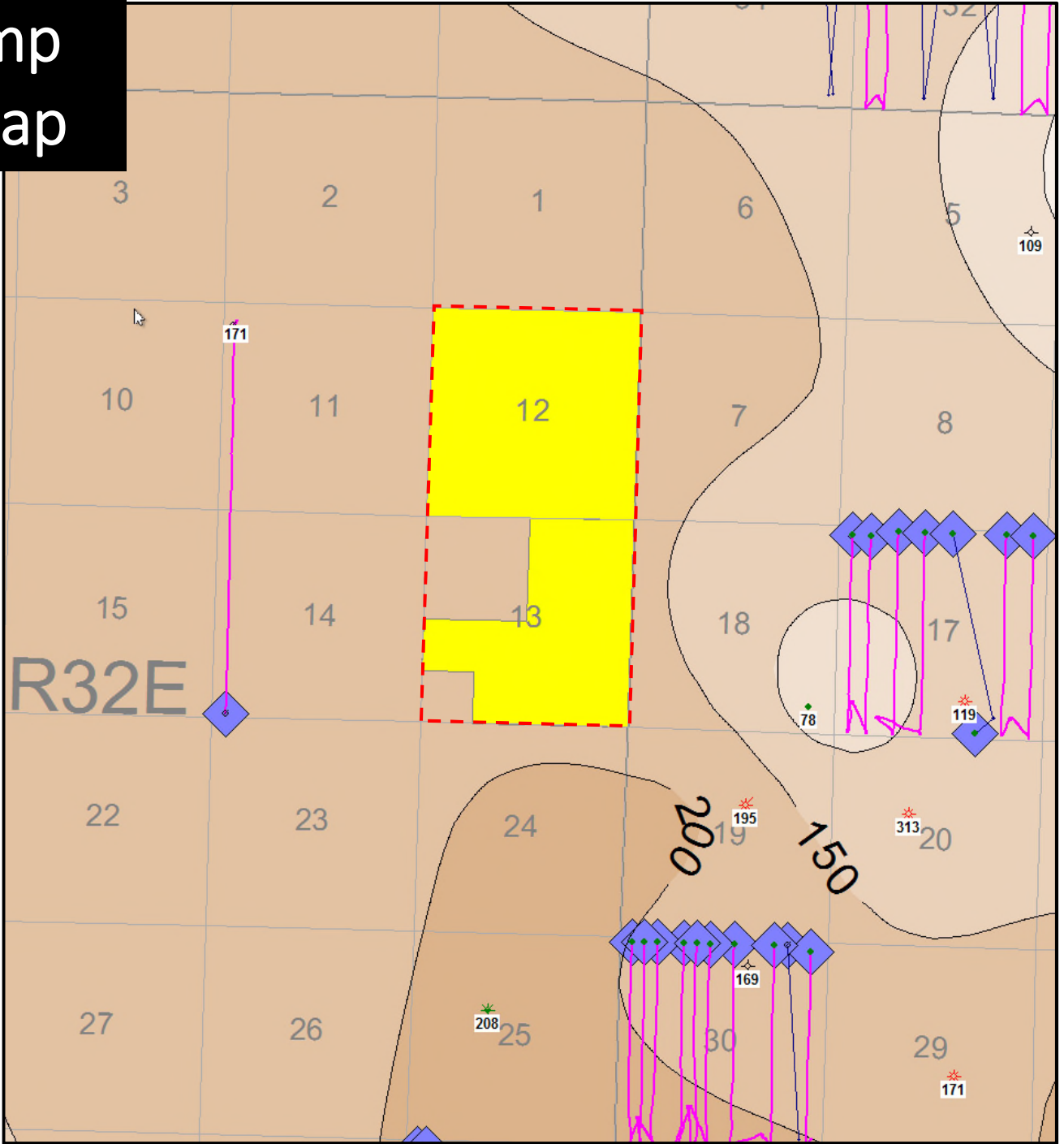

Upper Wolfcamp Net Porosity Map



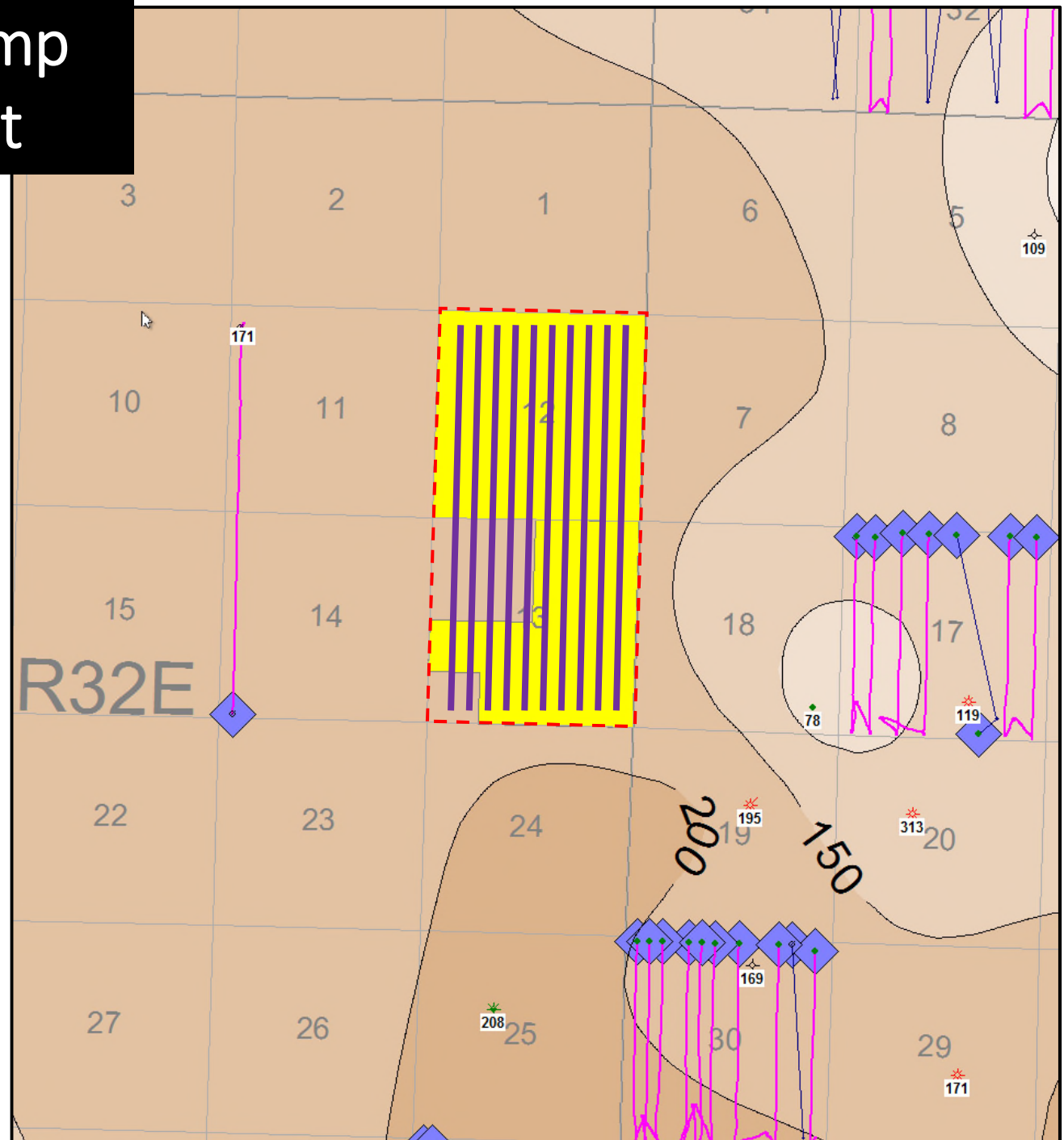


