Applicant seeks an order authorizing the injection of produced water for disposal purposes

through its proposed Grama State SWD No. 2 (API pending), which will be located 351 feet from

the north line and 215 feet from the west line (Lot 4, Unit D), Section 2, Township 22 South, Range

34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed injection disposal interval will be

within the Devonian, Fusselman formation (SWD; Devonian-Silurian, Pool Code 97869) between

14,400 feet and 15,500 feet below the ground through an open hole completion. The maximum

proposed daily injection rate will be approximately 30,000 barrels per day. The estimated average

injection pressure is expected to be approximately 2,160 psi (surface pressure). The maximum

injection pressure will be 2,880 psi (surface pressure). Disposal fluid will be produced salt water

from oil and gas wells in the area producing from various formations, including the Yates, Bone

Spring, Wolfcamp, Strawn and Morrow. The Applicant will demonstrate that the proposed

injection well will not impair correlative rights of V-F or any other lessee, will prevent waste of

State resources and will protect groundwater.
