CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: The matter before the 2 3 Commission is Case Number 16403, currently set for rehearing to reconsider the application submitted by Hilcorp Energy 4 5 Company to amend the well density and location requirements 6 and administrative exceptions of the special rules for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, Rio Arriba and San Juan County, 7 8 New Mexico. 9 Currently the parties previously recognized by the Commission include the OCD, the State Land Office, and 10 Enduring Resources. Additionally, the San Juan Citizens 11 Alliance has filed a renewed amended notice for intervention 12 13 in this matter. Will the parties please make their appearances, 14 beginning with the applicant, Hilcorp Energy Company. 15 16 MR. FELDEWERT: Madam Chairman, Commission, Michael Feldewert of the Santa Fe Office of Holland & Hart 17 appearing on behalf of the applicant, Hilcorp Energy. 18 MR. RANKIN: Madam Chair, Commissioners, Adam 19 Rankin of the office of Holland & Hart appearing on behalf 20 of Enduring Resources. 21 MS. ANTILLON: Madam Chair, Commissioners, Andrea 22 23 Antillon on behalf of the State Land Office. MS. GUARINO: Madam Chair, Commissioners, Julia 24 Guarino on behalf of San Juan Citizens Alliance, and I have 25

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1 co-counsel, Erik Schlenker-Goodrich.

2 MR. WEED: Good morning, Gabriel Weed on behalf 3 of the Oil Conservation Division.

4 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Since I assume that Hilcorp 5 will reassert its objection to SJCA's intervention should 6 the pending unopposed motion be denied, if there is no 7 objection, I would like the parties, including the SJCA, to 8 provide any statements that they have prepared regarding the 9 unopposed motion to amend the special rules for the 10 Blanco-Mesaverde Pool currently before this Commission.

Since it was the party that filed the motion, the
 State Land Office may address the Commission first.

MS. ANTILLON: Madam Chair, Commissioners, the
State Land Office has worked together with all the parties
present today to come up with the unopposed motion.

There has been a last-minute change or potential change due to the updated definitions of the vertical and horizontal wells, and we would request that the parties have just a short break to convene and consider this last-minute change and hope that we can get this motion agreed to and resolved today.

22 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Are there any objections 23 from the other parties?

24 MR. FELDEWERT: No objection from Hilcorp.25 MS. GUARINO: No objection from Citizens

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Page 6 Alliance. 1 MR. WEED: No objection from the Oil Conservation 2 3 Division. CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: How long do you 4 5 expect you'll need a break? MS. ANTILLON: Five or 10 minutes at the most. б 7 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Okay. We'll go into a ten-minute recess then. 8 (Recess taken from 9:05 a.m. to 9:33 a.m.) 9 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: All right. This meeting is 10 called back to order. We will now go into statements on the 11 new amendment. Does the State Land Office want to address 12 13 the Commission? MS. ANTILLON: Yes. Thank you, Madam Chair and 14 Commissioners. After discussions with all of the parties, I 15 16 would like to reassert the unopposed motion that the State Land Office previously filed, but with two minor changes in 17 Section 1B, Well Density, Paragraph 1. The change would be 18 from vertical wells to vertical or directional wells. And a 19 similar change in Paragraph 2 below that, it would be 20 existing vertical or directional wells. 21 And all the parties here today have agreed to 22 23 that proposed change and are in favor of the unopposed motion that has been filed by the State Land Office. 24 25 So I would ask, with those two changes, that the

Page 7 Commission accept the State Land Office's motion and propose 1 an order consistent with that. 2 3 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Any other remaining parties want to make a statement? 4 5 MR. FELDEWERT: Madam Chairman, Members of the 6 Commission, I will just reiterate that Hilcorp does not oppose the amendments to what had previously been adopted. 7 MS. GUARINO: Madam Chair, Commissioners, San 8 Juan Citizens Alliance also supports the proposed motion 9 10 with amendments and appreciates all of the parties working 11 together. MR. WEED: Madam Chair, Members of the 12 13 Commission, the Oil Conservation Division is in agreement with the proposed agreement. 14 MR. RANKIN: Madam Chair, Commissioners, Enduring 15 16 Resources does not oppose the amendment, just for the 17 record. CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: All right. The Commission 18 will immediately deliberate regarding this motion. Pursuant 19 to the Administrative Adjudicatory Deliberations Exceptions 20 to the Open Meetings Act, Section 10-15-1(H)(3), the 21 Commission may deliberate in closed session. I will 22 23 entertain a motion to go into closed session. 24 COMMISSIONER ENGLER: I move that the meeting be closed pursuant to the Administrative Adjudicatory 25

Page 8 Deliberations Exception to the Open Meetings Act, Section 1 10-15-1(H)(3) to deliberate Case 16403. 2 3 COMMISSIONER DAWSON: Second. CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Florene, can we talk a roll 4 5 call? 6 MS. DAVIDSON: Yes. Commissioner Engler? COMMISSIONER ENGLER: Yes. 7 MS. DAVIDSON: Commissioner Dawson? 8 COMMISSIONER DAWSON: Yes. 9 10 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: The motion carries and the Commission will now go into closed session at 35 after. 11 12 (Closed session was held beginning at 9:35 a.m. 13 and concluded at 9:48 a.m.) CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: All right. The Commission 14 meeting and the record is now reopened at 9:48. 15 The 16 discussion during the closed session was limited to the deliberation of the pending unopposed motion in Case Number 17 18 16403. Is there a motion from the Commission regarding 19 the amended unopposed motion to amend the special rules for 20 the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool? 21 COMMISSIONER ENGLER: Yes, Madam Chair. 22 I move 23 to grant the unopposed motion to amend the special rules for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool with the included amendments 24 provided by the parties during this hearing. 25

Page 9 As the applicant, Hilcorp is directed to draft 1 the proposed amended order of the Commission to include the 2 3 current status of the case, as well as the amended special rules, this proposed order shall be provided to the 4 5 Commission counsel ten days prior to the September 6 Commission meeting. CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Is there a second? 7 COMMISSIONER DAWSON: Second. 8 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: All those in favor say aye. 9 10 COMMISSIONER DAWSON: Aye. COMMISSIONER ENGLER: Aye. 11 12 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Aye. The motion carries. 13 (Ayes are unanimous.) MR. LOZANO: Counselors, we are going to decide 14 on a September meeting date as part of this hearing so you 15 16 will have that by the end of the meeting. MR. FELDEWERT: If I may, I think there is one 17 other housekeeping matter, and that is, there is some 18 additional exhibits that we need to introduce before we 19 close this case. 20 If I may, Madam Chairman, Members of the 21 Commission, at the public hearing Hilcorp presented evidence 22 23 Exhibits 1 through 6. Then at the public hearing in 24 November, Hilcorp presented some additional evidence and entered into evidence Exhibit 1A and Exhibit 7A. 25

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1 We now have provided to you, and I hope you all 2 have copies of what we've marked as Hilcorp Exhibits 9 and 3 10, and what they do is demonstrate compliance with the 4 notice required by the Commission's January order for 5 rehearing.

6 So to walk you through this, Exhibit Number 9 is 7 an affidavit from my office confirming that certified 8 mail -- or notice by certified mail of this hearing was sent 9 out on July 3rd to the last known addresses of the parties 10 that are listed in the pullout. Okay.

I believe my, if my count is correct, there is 11 178 different entries on there. And you will see in the 12 last column it provides the last known status of the postal 13 service delivery, these entries here, and what you see on 14 here include all the division designated operators in the 15 16 San Juan Basin which actually extend beyond the pool boundaries and beyond the two-mile buffer in the pool 17 boundaries, thereby providing the notice required by your 18 rules. It also includes on this list the federal, state and 19 tribal agencies that were listed in your order to provide 20 notice. 21

Exhibit 10 is an affidavit of publication from the newspapers in Rio Arriba County and also from the newspaper in San Juan County, and it confirms that notice of this hearing was published, let's see, in Rio Arriba it was

Page 11 July 11, and in San Juan it was on July 5. And you will see 1 that it was directed, the notice was directed to all 2 3 operators in the Blanco-Mesverde Gas Pool and other affected parties. 4 5 This complies with notice requirements from the 6 last hearing, and we ask that Exhibits 9 and 10 be accepted into the record at this time. 7 MR. LOZANO: Madam Chair, if I may, there was an 8 issue regarding Navajo Nation Chapters. How did that result 9 in terms of notice. Did you notify all the Chapters, or 10 just the Chapter inside of the pool? 11 MR. FELDEWERT: We notified the Chapter that was 12 13 directed in the Commission's order. MS. ANTILLON: Madam Chair, Commissioners, if I 14 may, in addition to the notification that was required of 15 16 Hilcorp, the State Land Office also is going to provide copies of the unopposed motion that we filed to all of the 17 Chapter Houses required by the San Juan Citizens Alliance. 18 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: Are there any objections to 19 including this in the record? 20 MS. ANTILLON: No objection. 21 22 MS. GUARINO: No objection. 23 MR. WEED: No objection. 24 CHAIRWOMAN SANDOVAL: These exhibits are admitted 25 for the record.
