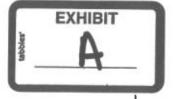

Ryan Gyllenband, being duly sworn, deposes and states:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a land supervisor for Marathon Oil Permian LLC and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as an expert petroleum landman were accepted by the Division as a matter of record.
- 2. My area of responsibility at Marathon includes the area of Lea County in New Mexico.
 - 3. I am familiar with the applications filed by Marathon in these cases.
 - 4. I am familiar with the status of the lands that are subject to these applications.
- 5. I submit the following information pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1) in support of the above referenced compulsory pooling applications.
- 6. No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed wells, but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests in the wells.



- 7. In the applications Marathon filed, Marathon seeks to force pool the working interests owner into the horizontal spacing units described in the applications, and in the wells to be drilled in the units.
- 8. Attached as **Exhibit 1** is the application for Case No. 20870. In Case No. 20870, Marathon seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within the Bone Spring formation underlying the W/2 E/2 of Section 11 and the W/2 NE/4 of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the **Ender Wiggins 14 TB FC 35H** well, to be horizontally drilled.
 - 9. The producing area for the well will be orthodox.
- 10. Attached as **Exhibit 2** is the application for Case No. 20871. In Case No. 20871, Marathon seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2 E/2 of Section 11 and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the **Ender Wiggins 14 TB FC 17H** well, to be horizontally drilled.
 - 11. The producing area for the well will be orthodox.
 - 12. Attached as **Exhibit 3** are the proposed C-102s for the wells.
- 13. The C-102s identify the proposed surface hole locations, first take point, and bottom hole locations. The C-102s also identify the pool and pool code.
- 14. The pool is the Red Hills, Bone Spring East Pool, pool code 97369, which is an oil pool and has 40-acre building blocks.
- 15. Lease tract maps outlining the units being pooled are attached hereto as **Exhibit 4.**The parties being pooled and the percent of their interests is also included as part of Exhibit 4.
 - 16. There are no depth severances in the Bone Spring formation.

- 17. Marathon seeks to pool overriding royalty interest owners, and they were provided notice of this hearing.
- 18. Also included in Exhibit 4 is a summary of my contacts with the working interest owners.
- 19. Marathon have conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the wells are located, and conducted phone directory and computer searches to locate contact information for parties entitled to notification, and mailed all parties well proposals, including an Authorization for Expenditure.
- 20. In my opinion, Marathon has made a good faith effort to obtain voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed wells.
- 21. Exhibit 5 is a copy of a representative proposal letters sent to the working interest owners.
- 22. The proposal letter identifies the proposed first and last take points and approximate TVD.
- 23. **Exhibit 6** contains the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed wells. The estimated cost of the wells set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and is comparable to the costs of other wells of similar depths and length drilled in this area of New Mexico.
- 24. Marathon requests overhead and administrative rates of \$7500.00/month for drilling a well and \$750.00/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this area of Southeastern, New Mexico. Marathon requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.

- 25. Marathon requests the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against non-consenting working interest owners.
 - 26. Marathon requests that it be designated operator of the wells.
- 27. Marathon requests that it be allowed a period of one (1) year between when the wells are drilled and when the first well is completed under the order.
 - 28. Marathon requests expedited orders for these cases.
- 29. **Exhibit 7** is an affidavit of notice prepared by counsel for Marathon that shows the parties who were notified of this hearing, the status of whether they received notice, and an affidavit of publication from the Hobbs-News Sun newspaper, showing that notice of this hearing was published on November 1, 2019.
- 30. The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.
- 31. I attest that the information provided herein is correct and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.
- 32. The granting of these applications is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

In support of this application, Marathon states as follows:

- 1. Marathon is an interest owner in the subject lands and has a right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Marathon seeks to dedicate the W/2 E/2 of Section 11 and the W/2 NE/4 of Section 14, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to form a 240-acre, more or less, spacing unit.

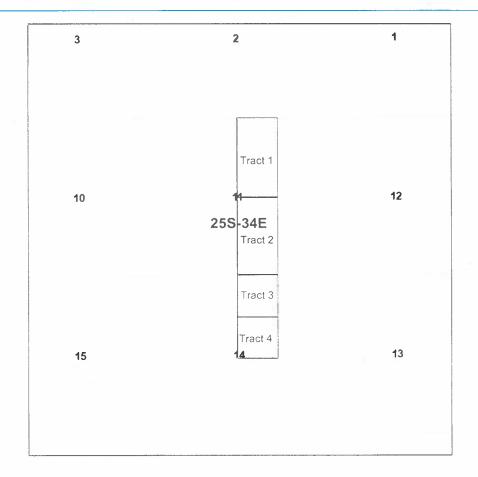

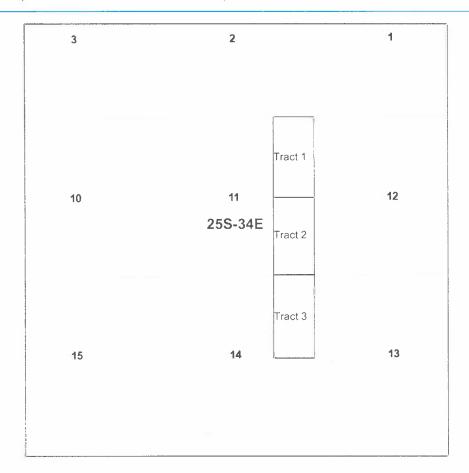

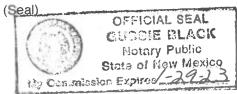

Thomas Lockwood, being duly sworn, deposes and states:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a geologist for Marathon Oil Permian LLC, and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as an expert petroleum geologist were accepted by the Division as a matter of record.
- 2. My area of responsibility at Marathon includes the area of Lea County in New Mexico.
 - 3. I am familiar with the application filed by Marathon in this case.
- 4. **Exhibit 8** is a locator map showing the approximate location of the proposed wells in relation to the Capitan Reef.
- 5. **Exhibit 9** is a wellbore schematic showing the proposed Bone Spring wells within the unit, as well as the proposed Wolfcamp wells.
- 6. The exhibits behind **Tab 10** are the geology study I prepared for the Ender Wiggins 14 TB FC 35H and the Ender Wiggins 14 TB FC 17H, which are Bone Spring wells.



- 7. **Exhibit 10-A** is structure map of the base of the Top of the Wolfcamp. The proposed project area is identified by a black-dashed box, and the proposed wells are identified by blue lines. The contour interval used this exhibit is 25 feet. This exhibit shows that the top of the Wolfcamp dips toward the east.
- 8. Exhibit 10-B identifies four wells in the vicinity of the proposed Third Bone Spring wells, shown by a line of cross-section running from A to A'.
- 9. **Exhibit 10-C** is a stratigraphic cross section hung on the top of the Wolfcamp. The well logs on the cross-section give a representative sample of the Third Bone Spring sand formation in the area. The target zone is identified by the words "Producing Zone" and the shaded area across the cross section, along with a red arrow.
 - 10. In my opinion, the Third Bone Spring Sand thins slightly to the north.
- 11. Exhibit 10-D is a Gross Interval Isochore of the Third Bone Spring Sand. The Third Bone Spring Sand thins slightly to the north.
 - 12. I conclude from the maps that:
 - a. The horizontal spacing units are justified from a geologic standpoint.
 - b. There are no structural impediments or faulting that will interfere with horizontal development.
 - Each quarter quarter section in each of the proposed units will contribute more or less equally to production.
- 13. Exhibit 11 provides an overview of the stress orientation in the area based on the 2018 Snee-Zoback paper.
- 14. The preferred well orientation in this area is North/South. This is because the S_{Hmax} is at approximately 70-80 degrees in southern-Lea County.

- 15. Exhibits 8-11 were prepared by my or under my supervision or compiled from company business records.
- 16. In my opinion, the granting of Marathon's application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

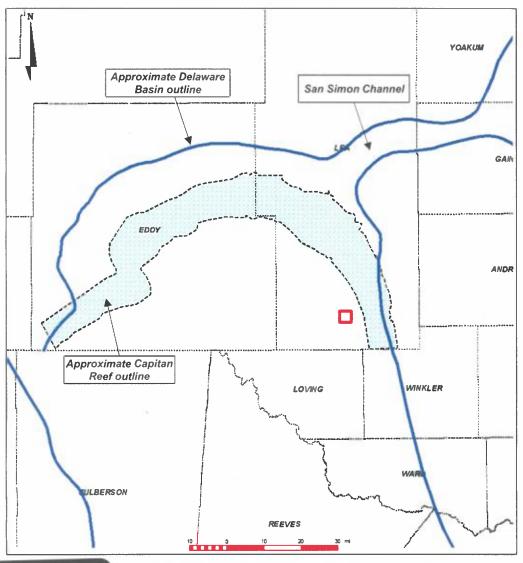

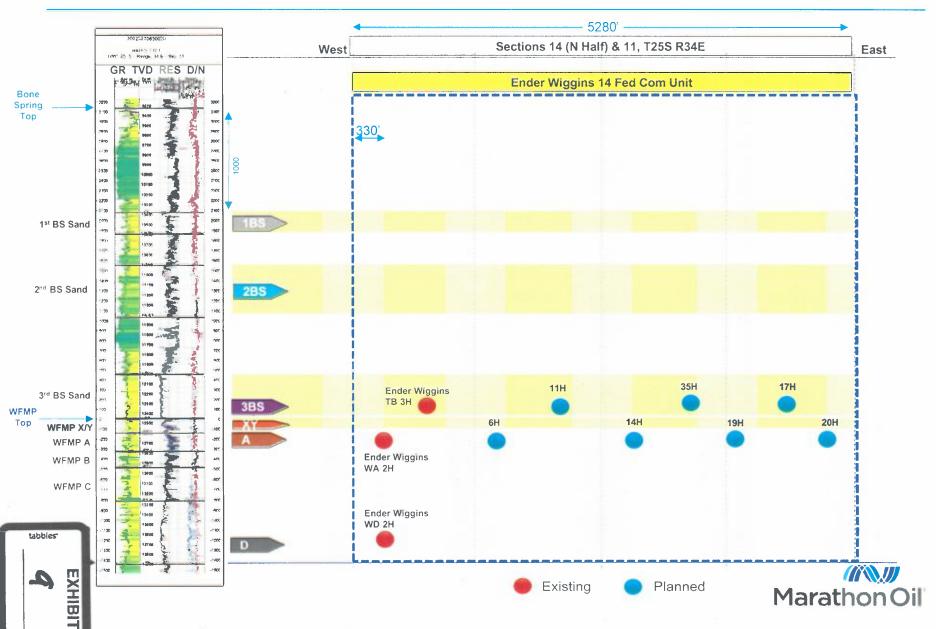

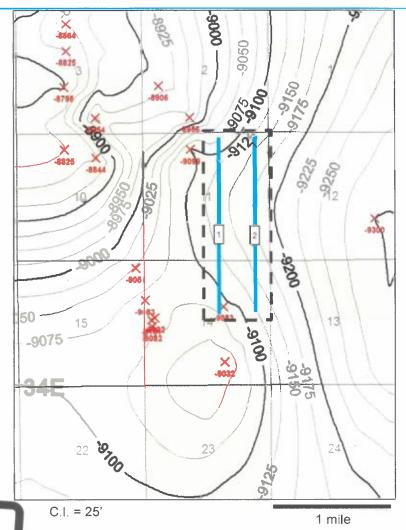




Wellbore Schematic

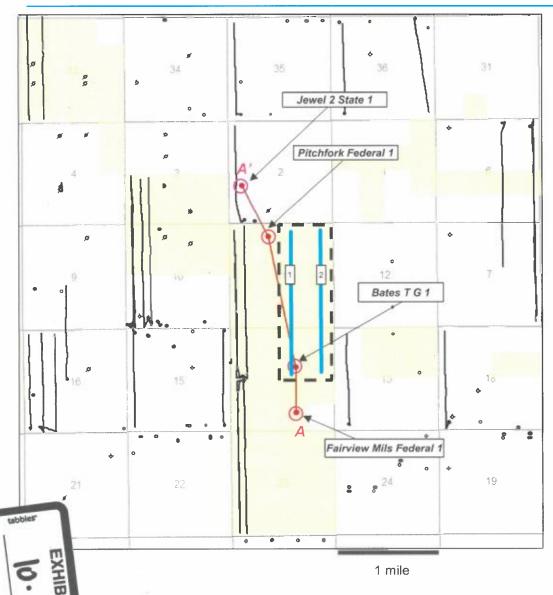

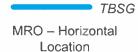

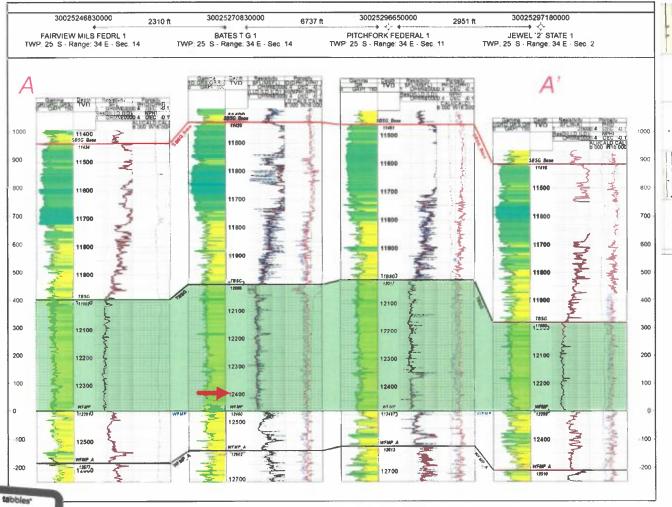

Stratigraphic Cross Section for Bone Spring Wells (Top of Wolfcamp Datum)





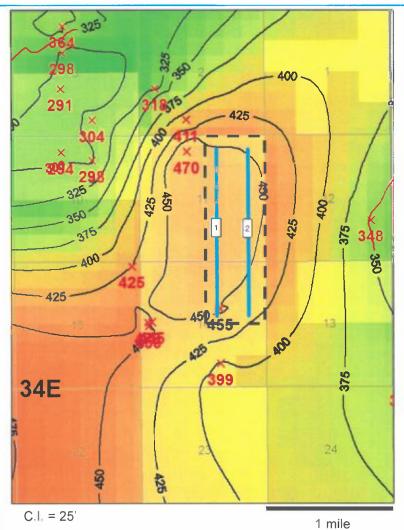

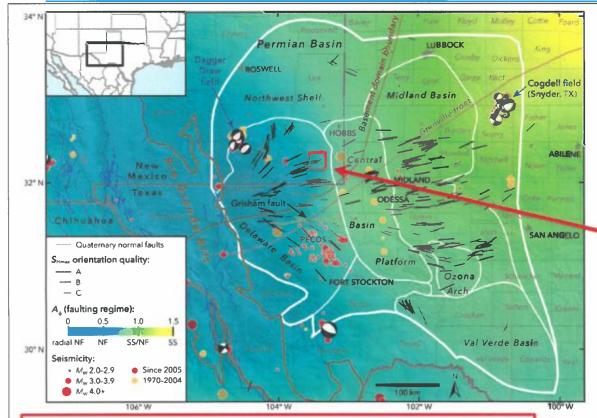


Figure 1. State of stress in the Permian Basin, Texas and New Mexico. Black lines are the measured orientations of the maximum horizontal stress (S_{ana}), with line length scaled by data quality, the colored background is an interpolation of measured relative principal stress magnitudes trauting regime, expressed using the A_a parameter (see text for details) of Simpson (1997). Blue lines are fault traces known to have experienced normal-sense offset within the past 1.6 Ma, from the USGS Quaternary Faults and Folds Database (Crone and Wheeler, 2000). The boundary between the Shawnee and Mazatzal basement domains is from Lund et al. (2015), and the Precambrian Grenville Front is from Thomas (2006). The Permian Basin boundary is from the U.S. Energy Information Administration, and the subbasin boundaries are from the Texas Bureau of Economic Geology Permian Basin Geological Synthesis Project. Earthquakes are from the USGS National Earthquake Information Center, the Toward Smith Could University (Herrmann et al., 2011).
