STATEMENT OF CASES

APPLICANT:

In Case No. 20982, Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2 of Sections 2 and 11, Township 25 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the Parade State 603H well and the Beauty Queen Fed Com 604H well, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for the Parade State 603H well will be unorthodox. The producing area for the Beauty Queen Fed Com 604H well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said wells, and allowing a one year period between when the first well is drilled and when the wells are completed.

In Case No. 20983, Franklin Mountain Energy LLC seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit underlying the W/2 E/2 of Sections 2 and 11, Township 25 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the Parade State 704H well, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for the well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well, and allowing a one year period between when the well is drilled and completion of the well.
