STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 21000: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation in a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 36 and the NE/4 of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Easy Company 36/35 W0AB Fed Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of 36 and a final take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 35.

Case No. 21001: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2N/2 of Section 36 and the N/2NE/4 of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Easy Company 36/35 B3AB Fed Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of 36 and a final take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 35.

Case No. 21002: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation in a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2N/2 of Section 36 and the S/2NE/4 of Section 35, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the Easy Company 36/35 B3HG Fed Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the SE/4NE/4 of 36 and a final take point in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 35.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells.
