SAVAGE: Darin Savage, Santa Fe office of Abadie & Schill for Devon Energy Production Company LP. I 5 would like to do this by affidavit, and I would also like to 6 consolidate 21119, 21120, 21121, 21122 and 21123 and also do 7 8 those by affidavit as well. 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you for those. 10 Sounds like a good idea, and we have no other entries of appearance. 11 12 MR. SAVAGE: Applicant has met all notice 13 requirements for the application in a timely manner, and as 14 a result we move that the application, affidavits, exhibit 15 checklist for all the cases I have mentioned herein be admitted by the examiner and taken under advisement. I can 16 17 answer any questions you may have. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: If you would just mention 18 19 where the notice requirements are at. MR. SAVAGE: Notice requirements are on Exhibit C 20 of each case, the affidavit, copy of the notice letters and 21 copy of the timely publication. 22 23 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I'm sorry, which exhibit? 24 PLAINTIFF COUNSEL: Exhibit C of each case. So 25 if you look at the table of contents which is labeled, you

Page 4 will see the Exhibit C for cases 21119, Tab 4, and then a 1 2 list, the other exhibits, all the notice requirements are listed in Exhibit C for each one. 3 4 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. So it will be important to, I think, to review the table of contents 5 because the tabs are numbered, but the exhibits are 6 lettered. Okay. And have had you a moment? Do you have 7 8 questions? It's a thick packet. 9 EXAMINER MURPHY: It's a thick packet, but it 10 looks really good. It looks really thorough. The wells are covering -- all the wells are covering Section 23 and 26? 11 12 MR. SAVAGE: Yes, ma'am, in both sections, and 13 there's a very closely related geology, as well as uniform 14 and closely related ownership throughout those two sections 15 for both formations. EXAMINER MURPHY: Is it near the potash area? 16 17 Did I see something that looks like that? MR. SAVAGE: Eddy County, Section 23 and 26. 18 23 South -- I did not note in relation to the potash area. 19 EXAMINER MURPHY: Maybe it's near Salina in one 20 21 of the -- no, that looks like potash mines right there, on 22 2. 23 MR. SAVAGE: Two miles of Loving, New Mexico, and 24 two miles southeast of Carlsbad. 25 EXAMINER MURPHY: In Tab 5 it does show the

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1	potash. So will they have to drill off of one of the drill
2	islands in there? I'm sorry, it's just in the potash one
3	of the potash mines is in the aerial photos, it doesn't
4	necessarily mean
5	MR. SAVAGE: I can find the specifics for that
6	and follow up with that if there is any question on that
7	matter.
8	EXAMINER MURPHY: I suspect the people that will
9	review this will let you know if you have any issues. It
10	looks like a great exhibit submittal.
11	MR. SAVAGE: A lot of information, I appreciate
12	being able to consolidate because some the units do not
13	overlap directly, but they are all related in those two
14	sections.
15	EXAMINER MURPHY: I have no further questions.
16	HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. The packet is
17	accepted and will be taken under advisement.
