1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: We will handle a few more
2 affidavit cases before we take a break. Next we have 21131,
3 and presumably the two Mewbourne Oil compulsory pooling
4 relating to a well named Hereford 2.

5 MR. BRUCE: Jim Bruce of Santa Fe representing
6 the applicant and submitting this case by affidavit.

7 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you.

8 MR. BRUCE: Both cases by affidavit.

9 MR. RANKIN: Adam Rankin on behalf of XTO.

10 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Do you object
11 to Mr. Bruce -- object to Mr. Bruce presenting the matter
12 by affidavit?

13 MR. RANKIN: No objection.

14 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you.

15 MR. BRUCE: In these cases, they involve land in
16 19 South, 35 East. The first case, 21131, is the pooling of
17 the Bone Spring well in the E/2 E/2 of Sections 28 and 29.
18 21132 is the pooling of the Wolfcamp formation in the W/2
19 E/2 of Sections 20 and 29.

20 Notice is complete, all of the parties being
21 pooled received actual notice by certified mail, so the
22 publication affidavit wasn't -- in both cases originally
23 Mewbourne sought to pool the interests of a person named --
24 I will have to spell this out for you -- Velta V-e-l-t-a and
25 her last name is Daigneault D-a-i-g-n-e-a-u-l-t, she should

1 be dismissed from the pooling proceedings because we have
2 come to terms with her.

3 And with that I move the admission of exhibits 1
4 and 6 and ask that the matters be taken under advisement.

5 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Any questions, Ms.
6 Murphy?

7 EXAMINER MURPHY: You have your checklist and
8 Exhibit 6 or Tab 6, I have no further questions.

9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Bruce.
10 The packet is accepted and the matters will be taken under
11 advisement.
