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Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move on then to 2 Case Numbers 20904, 20905, 20906, 20907, 20908, 20909, 20910, 20911. This is Matador Production, compulsory 3 4 pooling matter. All of those matters are for a well named 5 Michael K. 6 Mr. Bruce? 7 MR. BRUCE: Yes, representing the applicants and 8 submitting the case by affidavit. 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Now, I also 10 have appearances from Marathon. Is there someone here for Marathon? 11 12 MS. BRADFUTE: Madam Examiner, this is Jennifer 13 Bradfute with Marathon Oil Company. 14 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. And, Ms. 15 Bradfute, do you have any objection to the matter proceeding by affidavit? 16 17 MS. BRADFUTE: No, Marathon does not. Thank you. 18 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. And then an appearance from Holland & Hart for EOG. 19 20 MS. LUCK: Good morning, Madam Examiner, Kaitlyn Luck on behalf EOG Resources Inc. EOG does not have an 21 objection to the case being presented by affidavit based on 22 23 the understanding there will be a special payment provision 24 included in the order, and EOG has submitted an exhibit with 25 that payment provision.

Page 4 MR. BRUCE: Jim that's acceptable to Matador. 1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you very much, Ms. 2 And Mr. Bruce, if you would proceed. 3 Luck. 4 MR. BRUCE: These eight cases collectively cover all of Sections 21 and 22, in 20 South, Range 29 East. 5 The 6 first four cases involve pooling of the Bone Spring formation. These are two-mile lateral wells in -- in 7 8 laydown well units. The final four cases involve the Wolfcamp, pooling of the Wolfcamp formation. 9 10 The usual exhibits are submitted. There is a landman affidavit, a geology affidavit. The exhibit package 11 12 is rather large because notice was given to over 100 13 persons, and so that is probably over 100 pages of land, 14 certified mailings in this exhibit package. And there is 15 also -- there are also two affidavits of publication that were submitted to the Carlsbad newspaper, just to make sure 16 that, when you are mailing that many notices out, there are 17 certain ones that are bound to come back, and there was a 18 bunch of them that came back. So people were noticed either 19 by certified mail or by publication. 20 And then of course the applications are enclosed, 21 and there is a pooling checklist for each case at the end of 22 the exhibit package. And with that, I would ask if the 23 24 Division has any questions. 25 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Mr. Coss, do you have any

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2 EXAMINER COSS: You know, I don't know a 3 question, so much as a curiosity. That special payment 4 provision indicated by Ms. Luck, do you have any details on 5 that? Are the details of it provided in the packet? MR. BRUCE: I did not include them, but I believe 6 7 yesterday Ms. Luck submitted them on line to the Division, 8 and so they should be in the Division's files. And, as I 9 said, Matador has agreed to that language. 10 MS. LUCK: Can I --MR. BRUCE: Go ahead, Kate. 11 12 MS. LUCK: This is Kaitlyn. I submitted as EOG's 13 Exhibit 1, and it has the language of the payment provision 14 included, and that was e-mailed in to the division on 15 April 14. EXAMINER COSS: Thank you, Kaitlyn. I quess I 16 17 bring this up because there was a question that was brought to my attention earlier this week by an interest holder in 18 some wells, a member of the general public, really, who was 19 curious to know about some of the payment provisions he saw 20 in the order. He was asked, so it's a newly-found interest 21 to see how some of those work, knowing that it's not 22 necessarily my purview. So I will take a look at it. 23 Thank 24 you, Kaitlyn. 25 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Coss. Mr.
