Order No. R-21135, as issued in Case No. 20979, created a 320-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit consisting of the E/2E/2 of Section 30 and 31, Township 25 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and pooled all uncommitted interests within the Bone Spring formation; Delaware River BS Pool (Pool Code: 16800) underlying the unit.
