Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Moving then to the next 2 two matters, 3 and 4 on our list, Case Numbers 21221 and 3 21222, Mewbourne Oil, the applicant in each case, compulsory 4 pooling application. The name of the well is Perazzi 9-10. 5 Mr. Bruce, are you here for the applicant? 6 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 7 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Let me pause 8 a moment to see if anyone else is entering an appearance 9 this morning. 10 (No audible response.) HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: No? All right. 11 If you 12 please go ahead. 13 MR. BRUCE: I submitted a package of exhibits, 14 the usual applications and proposed ads, the landman's affidavit by Tyler Jolly, a geologist affidavit by Charles 15 Crosby. They have both previously been qualified as experts 16 before the Division. 17 18 These cases, the first case ending in 221 is to force pool the Bone Spring formation underlying the 19 _ _ underlying the S/2 S/2 of both Sections 9 and 10 in 20 20 South, 29 East. 21 22 The second application, 222, is to outline or to 23 pool the Wolfcamp formation underlying the same acreage. 24 Everyone has been given notice. There were one or two 25 returned envelopes, but -- at least as to the second, the

Page 4 1 Wolfcamp case, and notice was published as to both cases. 2 Those are Exhibits 5-A and 5-B. And also the pooling checklists are included. 3 4 One thing I would note is that when going through the technical exhibits, there is well data or some plats 5 6 showing the wells in the area. The only Third Bone Spring and Wolfcamp are highlighted on the plat. There are a 7 8 number of other wells, but those are Second Bone Spring wells, so they were not discussed in the testimony. 9 But other than that, I would move the admissions 10 of Exhibits 1-A through 6-B. 11 12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Ms. Murphy, do you have questions for Mr. Bruce? 13 14 EXAMINER MURPHY: I think I have a question. 15 Good morning, Mr. Bruce. 16 MR. BRUCE: Good morning. 17 EXAMINER MURPHY: So Mewbourne, who are they --18 is it a number of operators or -- and individuals or -- to force pool? 19 MR. BRUCE: Yes. If you -- Exhibit 2, if you go 20 back to attachments B-1 and B-2 of Exhibit 2, it contains a 21 listing of the working interest owners being pooled together 22 23 with their percentage interest. 24 In the Bone Spring well (unclear audio) owns 25 about -- owns or controls about 85 percent of the working

Page 5 interest owner in. The Wolfcamp well, they control about 60 1 2 percent of the working interest owner. These applications were filed four months ago and continued for obvious 3 reasons. They are -- I'm sure that Mewbourne has been 4 working and has probably whittled down the number of people 5 6 that need to be pooled, but I forgot to ask them that. I will, I will find out, and if anybody needs to be dismissed 7 8 from the pooling list, I will file that information with the 9 Division. 10 EXAMINER MURPHY: Okay. I was -- I do have the exhibit list, they are just kind of hard to look at on the 11 12 fly and sometimes I see the -- so they do have a majority of 13 the interest and nobody has objected? 14 MR. BRUCE: Correct. 15 EXAMINER MURPHY: And were there a number of individuals that were either known or unknown? 16 17 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: We thought they were all 18 known, but two people in the Wolfcamp case. I'm looking at the list. 19 20 EXAMINER MURPHY: What page are you on on the 21 list? 22 MR. BRUCE: In the first case, the Bone Spring 23 Case 221, all the parties were locatable. I did not get a 24 green card back from Brooks Oil and Gas, which is a company 25 of which David Brooks is part owner, but the BLM -- excuse

Page 6 me -- the post office records show that notice was received, 1 2 I just haven't gotten the green card back, but regardless, notice was published against everyone. 3 4 There are oil companies being pooled as well as individual people who are either lessees or unleased mineral 5 interest owners. In the Wolfcamp I did receive confirmation 6 7 of receipt of all the certified mail except as to two people 8 who I'm trying to locate right now. But again, notice was 9 published as against their, their names, and so --10 EXAMINER MURPHY: The bulk of the working interest owners don't object? 11 12 MR. BRUCE: We have received no objection from 13 anybody. 14 EXAMINER MURPHY: Thank you. I have no more 15 questions. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms. Murphy. 16 Let me pause for a moment in the event one of the other 17 technical hearing examiners has a question. 18 EXAMINER LAMKIN: Nothing from me either. 19 20 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Thank you very much, Mr. Bruce. Exhibits are accepted and the matter 21 will be taken under advisement. 22 23 MR. BRUCE: Thank you. 24 (Exhibits admitted.) 25 (Taken under advisement.)
