I wish to register comments regarding the upcoming hearing on regulations to govern produced water.

I oppose the use of fracked toxic waste, aka produced water, used for any purpose other than repurposed in fracking operations, and want strongly worded, enforceable regulations that prohibit the use of toxic waste water anywhere else.

There is no established science on if it is even possible to treat this toxic waste to the level required for the uses proposed.

There is significant evidence from studies in Pennsylvania and New York that use of toxic waste to deice roadways or reduce dust is unsafe.

I am concerned about the role of the gas and oil industry in creating these rules and in its role as a research partner with NMSU on fracked toxic waste.

The best way to preserve our water is to reduce or cease fracking operations.
