Dear Florene Davidson,

- I oppose the use of fracked toxic waste- "produced water" used for **any purpose other than repurposed in fracking operations** and want **strongly worded, enforceable regulations that prohibit the use of toxic waste water anywhere else.**
- There is no established science on if it is even possible to treat this toxic waste to the level required for the uses proposed;
- There is significant evidence from studies in Pennsylvania and New York that use of toxic waste to deice roadways or reduce dust is unsafe;
- **I want our water preserved for drinking and agriculture**, not used in fracking;
- I am concerned about the role of the gas and oil industry in creating these rules and in its role as a research partner with NMSU on fracked toxic waste;
- **The best way to preserve our water is to reduce or cease fracking operations.**
