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Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move then to case 2 Number 21371, WPX Energy Permian is the applicant. This is compulsory pooling and also for non-standard spacing unit. 3 4 The well name is French. 5 Mr. Savage are you here on behalf of the 6 applicant? 7 MR. SAVAGE: Yes, Madam Examiner, Darin Savage 8 available here on behalf of WPX Permian LLC. I believe this is a status conference. 9 10 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes. That's what I have you down down for. I also have an appearance for COG. Mr. 11 12 Rodriguez, are you here for COG this morning? 13 MR. This is a pooling application 25 for the subject lands listed in the summary. You know,

RODRIGUEZ: I'm sorry, could you repeat the 21 last date, Madam Examiner? 22 23 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: November 20, if I could 24 fit you in October 22, 23 depending on how things go in 25 relation to my earlier conversation with Mr. Feldewert,
