The public portions will be reported 3 and transcribed by a court reporter as is in a normal 4 5 meeting; the executive session portions are not public and will not be recorded or available by any attendees. Items 6 7 discussed in the closed session may be voted upon in the 8 open session when the session resumes. The special protocols for attorneys and 9 parties is as follows: As a courtesy to our member 10 parties and others listening, all particpants will be 11 12 muted. All members of the Commission participating remotely must identify themselves whenever they speak and 13 must be clearly audible to the other members of the 14 Commission and to the public. 15

16 Members and parties, or party attorneys 17 should avoid speaking over each other as much as possible. 18 All votes of the Commission during this meeting will be conducted by roll call vote. 19 Additionally, the chair will suspend the meeting if a 20 21 disruption in the audio or video occurs.
