The well is Maximus 5. 5 Who is here from Modrall Sperling for the б Applicant? Is that you, Ms. Bennett? MS. BENNETT: Yes, it is. Thank you, Madam 7 8 Examiner. 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let me pause for a moment to ask if there are any other entries of 10 11 appearance. 12 No. Please go ahead. 13 MS. BENNETT: Thank you. This is Deana Bennett on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian, LLC, in Case 21388. 14 15 In this case Marathon is seeking to pool 16 uncommitted mineral interest owners in a Wolfcamp spacing unit that underlies the north half of Sections 5 and 6, 17 Township 23 South, Range 28 East in Eddy County. It's the 18 Purple Sage Wolfcamp, so it's governed by the Purple Sage 19 Wolfcamp Order for setbacks. 20 21 Originally -- one thing I did want to point 22 out that's different from our Application and Proposal 23 Letters vs. the materials that are in front of you, is 24 originally Marathon was considering seeking an NSL 25 approval for nonstandard setbacks, but Marathon has

Page 4 decided to go with standard setbacks instead. And so the 1 2 C-102s that are in the packet identify the setbacks 3 correctly and are standard. So that's explained in the affidavit of the 4 5 landman, Mr. Rice, and his affidavit is behind or is Exhibit B, and the C-102s are behind his affidavit. б 7 This packet also contains the affidavit of a geologist with all the standard geology materials. 8 That's behind Exhibit C. 9 Exhibit A is the Compulsory Pooling 10 Checklist, which I filled out. 11 And the landman's affidavit has the Notice 12 materials, which includes my affidavit as Exhibit 7, as 13 well as Proof of Mailing, and although there weren't any 14 15 unlocatable interest owners, we also published as a matter 16 of course, and so the Exhibit 7 also includes the Affidavit of Publication 17 And all the materials were provided to the 18 Division, before 5:00 o'clock on Tuesday. 19 So with that I'd ask that the examiner 20 21 admit Exhibits A, B and C and their attachments into the record for Case No. 21388 and take Case No. 21388 under 22 23 advisement. 24 Thank you. 25 HEARING HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms.
