This is an Application For Compulsory Pooling, a nonstandard spacing 4 relating to a well named Toro. For Toro 22. 5 Mr. Padilla, are you with us on behalf of 6 7 the Applicant? 8 (Note: No response.) Mr. Padilla, you are muted. I'm unmuting 9 you. Mr. Padilla? 10 11 MR. PADILLA: Can you hear me now? 12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes. 13 MR. PADILLA: Okay. We're having computer issues on a big download from The Cloud and we were told 14 that the download would be completed overnight. 15 And it 16 apparently hasn't, and I don't have the band width to 17 appear on video, according to my computer. 18 So I am appearing on behalf of Colgate Operating for a Compulsory Pooling Order for the Toro 22 19 20 State and Federal 122H, and the Toro 22 Federal and State 21 132H. 22 I don't think there is any opposition to 23 this application. 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let me ask if there are 25 any other appearances this morning? (Note: Pause.) No?

Page 4 1 Go ahead, please, Mr. Padilla. 2 MR. PADILLA: We've submitted affidavits of Mark 3 Hajdik and Sergio Ojeda. Mr. Ojeda is a geologist and Mr. 4 Hajdik is a landman. They have appeared at the Division 5 and their credentials have been accepted as a matter of In fact in Case 21339, again Order 21406 which 6 record. 7 was issued about a month ago, we made application for 8 Wells 121H and the 131H, also in Section 22 of 19 South, 28 East. 9 The application and the affidavit are 10 pretty much in line to what we submitted in the prior 11 12 case. The reason that these two wells we are considering 13 today were not included in that prior application was just 14 simply a matter of communication between Colgate and this 15 office. So these two wells were not included in the prior 16 application. 17 They are one-mile laterals to test the Second and Third Bone Spring. The applications are very 18 straightforward, both from a land standpoint and from a 19 geologic standpoint. There are no impediments such as 20 21 fault, as far as geology is concerned, and all 40-acre tracts within the wellbore are believed to contribute 22 equally to oil and gas production from the wells. 23 24 The third exhibit, which is Exhibit C, is 25 my Affidavit of Notice. We did have to publish for a
