- 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Let's move,
- 3 then, to Case 21342. Tap Rock Resources is the Applicant,
- 4 Compulsory Pooling Application and then Application for
- 5 Unorthodox Well Location. The name of the well is Black
- 6 Marlin.
- 7 Mr. Bruce, you're here for the Applicant?
- 8 MR. BRUCE: Yes, I am.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. There's a number
- 10 of other parties: Franklin Mountain Energy, and then
- 11 Sandia Minerals.
- 12 Let's see. I got you, Ms. Bennett.
- MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Madam Examiner. It
- 14 is me, Ms. Bennett from Modrall Sperling on behalf of
- 15 Franklin Mountain Energy, LLC, I believe in this case, and
- 16 Sandia Minerals, LLC. Thank you.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. And then
- 18 Allar. Mr. Padilla?
- 19 Let's see. Mr. Padilla.
- MR. PADILLA: Why --
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Sorry? Mr. Padilla?
- MR. PADILLA: Yes.
- HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Thank you.
- 24 Then with Starboard Permian, Max Permian
- 25 and Monticello Minerals, who's here from Holland & Hart

- 1 for those parties?
- MS. LUCK: Kaitlyn Luck with Holland & Hart.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you,
- 4 Ms. Luck.
- 5 And finally Advanced Energy.
- 6 MS. HARDY: Good morning, Madam Examiner. Dana
- 7 Hardy with the Santa Fe office of Hinkle, Shanor. I'm
- 8 listed here as having entered an appearance but I believe
- 9 I actually only entered an appearance in Tap Rock Case
- 10 21341, which has been continued to another docket.
- 11 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Ah. Okay. Thank you
- 12 for that.
- MS. HARDY: Thank you.
- 14 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let me ask if there are
- 15 any other appearances this morning.
- MS. BLOUNT: Yes, ma'am. I am Joanne Blount,
- 17 and I am also representing my siblings Jane Berry, John
- 18 Brown, Jim Brown. And I'm just here to support Mr. Bruce
- 19 if he needs any other information from my family.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Oh, thank you, Ms.
- 21 Blount.
- 22 All right. So in the pleadings I saw,
- 23 Mr. Bruce submitted some pleadings noting that some
- 24 parties have been removed. I see that the exhibits were
- 25 sent timely.

1 Are there any objections from anyone to

- 2 Mr. Bruce proceeding by affidavit?
- MR. PADILLA: None from me. This is Ernie
- 4 Padilla.
- 5 MS. BENNETT: This is Deana Bennett. None from
- 6 me.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you
- 8 very much.
- 9 Mr. Bruce, if you would, please.
- 10 MR. BRUCE: Yes. This is a case seeking to pool
- 11 uncommitted interest owners in the Wolfcamp Formation in a
- 12 horizontal unit comprised of the east half/east half of
- 13 Section 18 and east half/east half of Section 19, 25
- 14 South, 36 East in Lea County for the purpose of drilling
- 15 three Wolfcamp wells which are identified in the
- 16 application.
- 17 Before we get going I think there is a
- 18 couple of things. One of those is at an unorthodox
- 19 location but the client didn't get me the offset notice
- 20 information in time, so I would ask that this Application
- 21 only be considered a pooling application, and we will file
- 22 for the unorthodox location administratively.
- 23 And then secondly, yesterday I filed some
- 24 Notices of Dismissal. Ms. Blount's family, the four
- 25 family members she identified are dismissed from the

1 Application. They are subject to a lease. And we have

- 2 also dismissed the Allar Company, Starboard Permian,
- 3 Monticello Minerals and Max Permian. Tap Rock continues
- 4 to work with them on this and the other Marlin wells that
- 5 are upcoming on the Division's docket next month or over
- 6 the next couple of months.
- 7 There is a landman's affidavit that
- 8 contains the usual C-102s; land plats; statement of the
- 9 types of interest the interest owners own; and the AFEs;
- 10 geologist's affidavit discussing the Wolfcamp geology in
- 11 detail.
- Notice was sent by Certified Mail, and so
- 13 an Affidavit of Notice is there. Some people I didn't get
- 14 green cards back from, but they were notified by an
- 15 Affidavit of Publication which is marked Exhibit E.
- 16 And finally the pooling checklist is
- 17 attached as Exhibit F.
- 18 I think everyone has been timely noticed
- 19 and all of the information required by the Division is in
- 20 the exhibit package, so I would move the admission of
- 21 Exhibits A through F and ask that the case be taken under
- 22 advisement.
- HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Bruce.
- Ms. Bennett, do you have any questions?
- 25 MS. BENNETT: No questions. And one thing I did

1 want to say at the outset that I forgot to say was just

- 2 that we are entering our appearance, or I'm entering my
- 3 appearance on behalf of the Franklin Mountain and Sandia
- 4 Minerals, LLC, entities to reserve our right to appeal in
- 5 the event that that's is necessary. But no questions and
- 6 no objections to the admission of the exhibits.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you.
- 8 Are there questions from anyone else?
- 9 MR. PADILLA: Yes, Madam Examiner. Ernest
- 10 Padilla.
- 11 It was my understanding that Mr. Bruce is
- 12 also going to dismiss this case against Emily Keatley
- 13 (phonetic).
- MR. BRUCE: Oh. Uhm, Mr. Padilla, Emily Keatley
- 15 does not own an interest in this well. She owns an
- 16 interest in Case 21340 only.
- 17 MR. PADILLA: Okay.
- MR. BRUCE: But she will be dismissed from that
- 19 action, as well as Allar.
- MR. PADILLA: Okay. Thank you.
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Padilla.
- 22 Any other questions?
- MS. LUCK: Madam Examiner.
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes. Ms. Luck.
- 25 MS. LUCK: I just wanted to say on the record no

1 objection and no questions from Starboard Permian, Max

- 2 Permian, or Monticello Minerals.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms. Luck.
- 4 Let me ask the technical examiners if they
- 5 have questions.
- 6 Mr. Cox.
- 7 (Note: No response.)
- 8 Mr. Cox.
- 9 EXAMINER COX: Oh, sorry. Was I muted still?
- 10 Oh, sorry. I was saying yes. Thank you,
- 11 Madam Examiner.
- I just want to remind you, Mr. Bruce, that
- 13 the Applications cases actually have to be filed for
- 14 administratively, they can't be filed for at hearing. So
- 15 that's perfect.
- MR. BRUCE: Okay.
- 17 EXAMINER COX: Another thing I want to ask is:
- 18 Do you have any Special Pay Provisions in this one?
- MR. BRUCE: No, I do not.
- 20 EXAMINER COX: Can you please use the newer
- 21 checklist we have posted in the future, it includes that
- 22 line on it, for me?
- MR. BRUCE: I did not know that. Okay. I will
- 24 do that.
- 25 EXAMINER COX: Thank you.
