1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move then from

- 2 21463 on to 21465 and 21466. The applicant is Colgate
- 3 Operating. These are compulsory pooling applications. The
- 4 well name is Dakota.
- 5 Ms. Bennett, are you here for the applicant?
- 6 MR. HOUGH: Madam Examiner, this Lance Hough from
- 7 Modrall Sperling on behalf of Colgate Operating LLC.
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Hough.
- 9 Let me pause for a moment to see if there are any other
- 10 entries this morning.
- 11 (No audible response.)
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I don't hear anything,
- 13 and I noticed you filed a prehearing statement, so if you
- 14 would please go ahead.
- MR. HOUGH: I just want to confirm if it's
- 16 acceptable to present cases 21465 and 21466 as consolidated.
- 17 They are -- I believe there is no opposition to either case.
- 18 They are adjacent units.
- 19 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes, please present.
- 20 MR. HOUGH: So for Case Number 21465, this is for
- 21 compulsory pooling of all uncommitted mineral interests
- 22 within a Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit underlying the
- N/2 and S/2 of Sections 32 and 31, and that's Township 19
- 24 South, Range 28 East, in Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 25 And for Case Number 21466, this is also for

- 1 compulsory pooling of all uncommitted mineral interests
- 2 within a Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit underlying the
- 3 S/2 S/2 Sections 32 and 31 in Township 19 South, Range 28
- 4 East in Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 5 Now, for the exhibits that have been submitted in
- 6 support of these two cases submitted on Tuesday, these
- 7 include as Exhibit A, the compulsory pooling application
- 8 checklist, one for each case. And then Exhibit B is the
- 9 affidavit of Mark Hajdik. He is the landman involved in
- 10 these matters.
- 11 There are corresponding exhibits for the land
- 12 matters attached to his affidavit which include a
- 13 communication time line, tract map with the working interest
- 14 owners and royalty interests involved there, the well
- 15 proposal letter, as well as applications for both cases, the
- 16 C-102s for the wells that are -- that the units are going to
- 17 be dedicated to, the authorization for expenditures for
- 18 these wells.
- 19 These wells include for, first case ending 65,
- 20 the wells are Dakota 32 State Fed Com 123H and 133H. For
- 21 the second case ending in 66, these include Dakota 32 State
- 22 Fed Com 124H and 134H.
- 23 And then the next exhibit is Exhibit C. That is
- 24 the affidavit of Sergio Ojeda. He is the geologist involved
- 25 in this matter. And the corresponding exhibits attached to

1 his affidavit include a regional locator map, cross section

- 2 locator map, a gunbarrel diagram, and then a structure and
- 3 isopach map for the Second Bone Spring formation, a
- 4 structure and isopach map for the Third Bone Spring
- 5 formation, as well as a stratigraphic cross section, and
- 6 then two more stratigraphic cross sections zoomed in on the
- 7 Second Bone Spring and Third Bone Spring.
- 8 And then the last tab, Exhibit D, is an affidavit
- 9 from myself regarding notice. And I provide there that
- 10 notice was timely mailed out, and we also have an affidavit
- of publication showing that we published notice out of an
- 12 abundance of caution.
- So with that, if the Division does not have any
- 14 questions, I would like to ask that these exhibits be
- 15 admitted into the record and these two cases be taken under
- 16 advisement.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Hough.
- 18 Mr. Simmons, do you have any questions of Mr. Hough?
- 19 TECHNICAL EXAMINER SIMMONS: I don't, no.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. In that case
- 21 your exhibits are admitted and the matters will be taken
- 22 under advisement.
