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1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move then to the

- 2 next set of matters. These are 21501, 21502, 21503, 21504.
- 3 Ascent Energy is the applicant. These are compulsory
- 4 pooling applications. The well name is Pony Express.
- 5 Mr. Bruce, you are here for Ascent?
- 6 MR. BRUCE: Yes.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. I saw an
- 8 entry of appearance on behalf of ConocoPhillips by Holland &
- 9 Hart?
- 10 MS. LUCK: That's correct, Madam Examiner.
- 11 Kaitlyn Luck with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on
- 12 behalf of ConocoPhillips.
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right, thank you.
- 14 And that was for all four matters. Then in two of the
- 15 matters I saw an entry of appearance on behalf of EOG.
- 16 MS. LUCK: That's correct. So Kaitlyn Luck again
- 17 with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on behalf of EOG
- 18 Resources, and this entry is specific to Cases 21503 and
- 19 21504.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you very much. Let
- 21 me pause for a moment to ask if there are any other
- 22 appearances this morning?
- 23 (No audible response.)
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I hear none. Ms. Luck,
- 25 do ConocoPhillips or EOG object to the matter proceeding by

- 1 affidavit?
- MS. LUCK: No objection from either party. Thank
- 3 you.
- 4 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Mr. Bruce, go
- 5 ahead.
- 6 MR. BRUCE: Yes, in this -- I'm first presenting
- 7 together 21501 and 21502, those are for certain Pony Express
- 8 Bone Spring and Wolfcamp wells. The land involved in each
- 9 of the two applications is the W/2 W/2 of Section 16 and the
- 10 W/2 W/2 of Section 24, 20 South, 33 East, and because of
- 11 land ownership, that's the reason for grouping together the,
- 12 the two applications.
- 13 The landman is Lee Zink, who has previously
- 14 testified before the the Division and been qualified as an
- 15 expert. His affidavit marked Exhibit 2 contains all the
- 16 usual information regarding land issues.
- 17 The land -- I must apologize somewhat to the
- 18 Division for the land and the geology exhibits because the
- 19 geology exhibits, they are identical for all of the six
- 20 cases that Ascent is presenting today. And so rather than
- 21 trying to ferret out what was necessary for each individual
- 22 case, I marked the exhibits pursuant -- at least the
- 23 geologic exhibits -- for those that covered the Bone Spring
- 24 formation and those that covered the Wolfcamp formation.
- 25 Anyway, 3-A is the exhibit for the Bone Spring

1 wells. 3-B is the geologic exhibit for the Wolfcamp wells.

- 2 Again it contains the normal information, the structure
- 3 maps, cross sections. The C-102s in this case are submitted
- 4 by the geologist and not the landman.
- 5 The data does show that in this area the stand-up
- 6 well units are preferred. Virtually everyone is drilling
- 7 stand-up wells both in the Wolfcamp and Bone Spring in this
- 8 area. If Mr. -- some of these exhibits, specially the cross
- 9 section, it looks better in color, and if Mr. Rose-Coss
- 10 would like a set of color exhibits, I can e-mail those to
- 11 him.
- 12 Notice was given by certified mail to everyone.
- 13 All interest owners or three parties being pooled did
- 14 receive actual notice, so notice was not published in the
- 15 newspaper.
- 16 The pooling checklists are marked Exhibits 5 and
- 17 6. And when I sat down late yesterday afternoon to go
- 18 through everything again, I did notice a couple of typos on
- 19 each of Exhibits 5 and 6. I will e-mail to the Division
- 20 replacement exhibits just correcting those typos so that
- 21 they are proper.
- There was a mistake in one of the well names or
- 23 the number I put in for one of the wells, I should say.
- 24 These wells are all 501 or 502 or 601 or 602, and I typed in
- 25 the wrong thing in one place. So I will get those to the

- 1 Division in these matters to clear that up.
- 2 But I believe all the necessary exhibits have
- 3 been submitted, and I would ask that the matters be taken
- 4 under advisement.
- 5 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you,
- 6 Mr. Bruce. Ms. Luck, do you have questions?
- 7 MS. LUCK: No questions from ConocoPhillips, and
- 8 no objections to the exhibits being admitted.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Mr.
- 10 Rose-Coss, do you have questions or any comment on the
- 11 exhibits being submitted in color?
- 12 TECHNICAL EXAMINER COSS: Yeah, it would be nice
- 13 to see some of the exhibits in color.
- MR. BRUCE: I will get that to you.
- 15 TECHNICAL EXAMINER COSS: Thank you, Mr. Bruce.
- 16 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. So, Mr.
- 17 Bruce, your exhibits are admitted, and the matters 21501 and
- 18 21502 will be taken under advisement. Please go ahead.
