**COG OPERATING LLC'S
PRE-HEARING STATEMENT**

COG Operating LLC ("COG") submits its Pre-Hearing Statement pursuant to the rules of the Oil Conservation Division.

APPEARANCES

COG is the applicant in this case. Its business address is 600 West Illinois Avenue, Midland, Texas 79701. COG is represented by the undersigned counsel.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

COG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the WC-025 G-09 S243532M; Wolfbone Pool (98098) underlying a 400.83-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 9, Township 25 South, Range 35 East, Lot 2, SW/4 NE/4 and W/2 SE/4 of irregular Section 4 (W/2 E/2 equivalent), Township 25 South, Range 35 East, and the W/2 SE/4 of Section 33, Township 24 South, Range 35 East in Lea County, New Mexico. The horizontal spacing unit will be dedicated to the Fez Federal Com #710H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit O of Section 9, Township 25 South, Range 35 East to a bottom hole location in Unit J of Section 33, Township 24 South, Range 35 East. The completed interval of the well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the costs of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the costs, the designation of COG

Operating, LLC as the operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The granting of COG's application will serve the interests of conservation, the protection of correlative rights, and the prevention of waste.
