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Page 5 1 (Time noted 9:10 a.m.) 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move then to 3 21340. Tap Rock Resources is the applicant. Compulsory 4 pooling application. The well name is Blue Marlin. 5 Mr. Bruce. MR. BRUCE: Yes, I'm here on behalf of the б 7 applicant. 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Other entries of appearance included Beadie and Wozniak for 9 Chevron? 10 11 MS. CALLAHAN: Good morning, Madam Examiner. 12 Candace Callahan appearing on behalf of Chevron. 13 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Good 14 morning. 15 And Abadie & Schill for Conoco Phillips. 16 MR. SAVAGE: Yes, Madam Examiner. Darin Savage here with Abadie and Schill for Conoco Phillips Company. 17 Thank you. 18 19 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Let me pause for a moment to see if there are any other appearances. 20 MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Madam Examiner, this 21 Deana Bennett at Modrall Sperling, and I had entered my 22 appearance on behalf of Franklin Mountain Royalty --23 24 Franklin Mountain Energy Royalty and Sandia Minerals. I 25 entered my appearance back in July. I'm not sure why I'm

Page 6 not shown on the list but I did just want to make sure 1 2 that my entry of appearance is notes for the record 3 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Sorry if I 4 overlooked that. 5 Let me pause again to see if there are any other entries of appearance in 21340. б 7 No? MR. RANKIN: Madam Chair? I'm sorry, Madam 8 Chair, Adam Rankin appearing on behalf of Monticello, 9 Starboard Permian and Max Permian. 10 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Thank you, 11 12 Mr. Rankin. This might be the, uhm, the matter in which 13 I thought Mr. Bruce had filed a document noting that there 14 15 were several folks not on the list sought to be compulsory 16 pooled anymore. 17 MR. BRUCE: That is correct. 18 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Am I remembering 19 that correctly? 20 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 21 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Okay. Thank you. So 22 will you be proceeding by affidavit this morning? 23 MR. BRUCE: Well, yes. And I want to clarify 24 something before I begin 25 I submitted the document on Tuesday.

Page 7 Unfortunately Mr. Lowe could not reopen them, or could not 1 2 open the document. It's a rather thick package of 3 exhibits. And I do not check my gmail account very often, 4 and Mr. Lowe had emailed me, so only this morning did I 5 break it up into two or three parts and get it to him as a .pdf, and I'm sure he has not had time to review that. б 7 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Mr. Bruce, let me interrupt you for just a minute. Ms. Shaheen emailed me 8 saying that she is trying to enter an appearance. I have 9 10 unmuted everyone I see to unmute. Ms. Shaheen, are you 11 with us? 12 MS. SHAHEEN: Good morning, Madam Examiner. You 13 hear me? 14 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes, I can. 15 MS. SHAHEEN: Yes. Thank you so much. 16 Yes, we had had entered an appearance for 17 Renalda Wilbert and Sandra Wilbert, and I understand that Tap Rock has dismissed them from this case so I just 18 wanted to note that we had entered an appearance and 19 acknowledge that we've been dismissed from this 20 21 proceeding. 22 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 23 Mr. Bruce, I'm sorry to have interrupted 24 If you would please proceed. you. 25 MR. BRUCE: Yes. That's okay.

Page 8 1 And just for the record: Yes, although 2 Mr. Padilla hasn't entered his appearance, he had 3 previously entered an appearance, but yesterday I filed a notice dismissing Mr. Padilla's, Ms. Bennett's, 4 Mr. Rankin's, and Ms. Shaheen's clients from this pooling 5 proceeding. They have all come to terms with Tap Rock. б 7 And the second thing is: I was stating, although I filed the exhibits I don't think Mr. Lowe has 8 had time to review them all. Let me go briefly through 9 the exhibits, and then, if necessary, I have a little 10 suggestion to make at the end. 11 12 I have submitted the normal package of 13 exhibits. It is A through F. 14 A is the application and proposed ad; 15 B is the Affidavit of Taylor Ford, the 16 landman; 17 Exhibit C is the affidavit of Emily Lange, the geologist; 18 19 Exhibit D is my Affidavit of Notice; E is the Affidavit of Publication from the 20 21 newspaper; 22 and F is the pooling checklist. 23 There are a number of parties being pooled 24 in this case -- a couple of working interest owners, 25 leasehold working interest owners, quite a large number of

Page 9 unleased mineral interest owners -- and they are all 1 2 identified in Exhibit B, the landman's affidavit. At 3 pages 1 and 2 each of the parties being pulled is noted. 4 The Proposal Letters that were sent out, I 5 think they were first sent out in March, are attached. 6 There were two separate Proposal Letters, one to resold 7 working interest owners, and one a simpler form letter to unleased working interest owners, and they all sought to 8 force pool or propose the well, the Blue Marlin Fed. Com 9 wells noted in the application. 10 There are six proposed wells all located in 11 12 the west half of Section 18 and the west half of Section 19 of 25 South, 36 East. This is a proximity 13 14 tract well unit, and the proximity, the well that defines 15 that is noted in Exhibit F, the Pooling Application 16 Checklist. The landman's affidavit contains all the 17 normal exhibits: Land plats showing the tracts and the 18 well units; the interest owners in the well units; the 19 AFEs; and the C-102s. 20 21 Exhibit C is a geologist affidavit, and 22 again the usual suspect exhibits are in there, including the structure map, cross sections, et cetera. 23 24 The Affidavit of Notice, like I said, when 25 it first went out there were quite a large number of

Page 10 parties being pooled. Almost all of them received the 1 2 Certified Mail, but there were some parties that refused 3 the mail or were unlocatable, and so Notice was published. 4 And that's Exhibit E. 5 And the checklist is Exhibit 5, as I said. I think the exhibit package is complete. 6 7 My only question is since Mr. Lowe has not had time to review the exhibit package, if necessary could 8 the case be continued, even just to November 5th, just so 9 Mr. Lowe has -- and I would file a continuance motion just 10 so Mr. Lowe has time to review the package to make sure 11 12 it's complete. 13 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: I don't think that 14 will be necessary, Mr. Jim Bruce, because it appears --15 because I got a chance to review it very quickly last 16 night about 10:30, so I got a quick glance at it, and it 17 appears to be okay. I have yet to review it in detail, but as of from what I've seen, what you presented, it 18 seemed to be okay. I don't think it's feasible enough to 19 just continue it on just because of that. 20 21 MR. BRUCE: Okay. Thank you. 22 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Lowe and Mr. Bruce. 23 24 Let me pause a moment to see if any of the 25 other parties have a question for you.

Page 11 MS. CALLAHAN: Excuse me, Madam Examiner. I 1 2 just would like to point out that Chevron has requested a 3 special hearing, which is included in the revised 4 checklist submitted by Mr. Bruce. MR. BRUCE: Yes, that's correct. There is a 5 special payment provision applicable to Chevron, and I 6 7 submitted an amended or revised Exhibit F yesterday containing the language requested by Chevron. 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I saw that. 9 Did you have anything further on that, Ms. 10 11 Callahan? 12 MS. CALLAHAN: I just wanted to point it out, 13 and maybe I guess a request on the record to include that 14 provision in any Order that's issued by the Division. 15 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 16 Are there any other questions or comments 17 by any of the other parties? 18 I hear nothing. 19 All right. In that case, Mr. Bruce, the exhibits are accepted and the matter 21340 will be taken 20 21 under advisement. 22 MR. BRUCE: Thank you. 23 (Time noted: 9:18 a.m.) 24 25
