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Page 4 1 (Time noted: 8:21 a.m.) 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move to the next 3 three matters 21438. Franklin Mountain is the applicant. 4 It's Compulsory Pooling Applications. Bus Driver is the well. 5 And who here is from Modrall Sperling on 6 7 behalf of Franklin Mountain for the Bus Driver well? 8 MS. BENNETT: Good Morning, Madam Examiner. This is Deana Bennett of Modrall Sperling on behalf of 9 Franklin Mountain Energy. 10 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Then 21441 and 21443, 11 12 still Franklin Mountain is the Applicant and another compulsory pooling application in this case is the Judge 13 14 Baylor --15 (Note: Reporter interruption.) 16 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms. 17 Macfarlane. I've been trying to pay attention to the muting here but let me make sure I still have my finger on 18 the button. 19 All right. Let's see. Where was I? 20 21441 21 and 21443, Franklin Mountain is the applicant, and the 22 well name is Judge Baylor. 23 Ms. Bennett, I take it you are still 24 representing Franklin Mountain Energy. 25 MS. BENNETT: That's correct, Madam Examiner.

Page 5 Deana Bennett on behalf of Franklin Mountain Energy. 1 2 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 3 Then COG entered an appearance. Mr. 4 Rodriguez, I see you out here. 5 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Yes, ma'am. Michael Rodriguez б with COG operating, LLC. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 7 Let me pause for a moment to see if there 8 9 are any other appearances. No? If you would, Ms. Bennett. Are we 10 proceeding by affidavit? 11 12 MS. BENNETT: Yes, Madam Examiner, I am. And 13 it's my understanding that Concho does not oppose these 14 cases going by affidavit. 15 MR. RODRIGUEZ: That is correct. 16 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you, 17 Mr. Rodriguez. 18 If you would, please, Ms. Bennett. MS. BENNETT: Thank, you Madam Examiner. 19 These three cases are companion cases to the four cases that I 20 21 put on on behalf of Franklin Mountain Energy on October 22 8th, 2020, and these three cases were continued at Concho's request to today's docket. So they are part and 23 24 parcel of Franklin Mountain Energy's development plan that 25 I presented on October 8th.

Page 6 These three cases -- well, I'll go through 1 2 each of the three packets individually, but each of the 3 three packets is set up the same way. The packets have the affidavit of the landman, Shelley Albrecht. And Ms. 4 Albrecht has testified before the Division and her 5 credentials have been accepted as a matter of record. 6 The 7 exhibits also contain the geology study preparied by Ben 8 Kessel, and Ben Kessel is the Franklin Mountain Energy geologist who has testified before the Division, and his 9 credentials have been accepted as a matter of record. 10 11 The packets also each contain a compulsory 12 pooling checklist which is Tab A of each of the packets, and you'll see that I have signed a receipt of the 13 compulsory pooling checklist. 14 And then included in each of Ms. Albrecht's 15 16 Albrecht's affidavit are the Notice materials, and the 17 Notice materials contain my affidavit where I certify that I did provide Notice of this hearing along with a copy of 18 the application, as required by the Division's rules, as 19 well as a Notice of Publication. And the Publication 20 21 Notices were all timely filed. 22 So with that overview, I'll start with Case No. 21438 which is the Bus Driver Fed. Com 602H well. 23 24 This is a Bone Spring well, and in this 25 case Franklin Mountain Energy is seeking to pool the Bone

Page 7 Spring interest underlying the east half/west half of 1 2 Sections 1 and 12, and the northeast guarter/northwest 3 quarter of Section 13, Township 26 South, Range 35 East. And this is will be 360-acre spacing unit. It's a 4 standard unit. 5 Exhibit B contains Ms. Albrecht's 6 7 affidavit, and behind Exhibit B are the exhibits you would expect to see. We have included a development overview, a 8 copy of the application, the C-102s. 9 Exhibit B-4 contains the lease tract map, 10 along with the unit recapitulation showing the owners and 11 12 their various percentages in the unit. 13 Exhibit B-5 is the summary of contacts. 14 B-6 is the Proposal Letter. 15 B-7 is the AFE. 16 B-8 is my Affidavit of Notice. 17 And again here you'll see the specs. We have a locator map, a Gun Barrel view of the development 18 plan, and then the geology study for this specific well, 19 which includes a structure map, a cross section locator 20 21 map, the cross section itself showing the logs that the 22 geologist used. He testifies that he -- in his opinion 23 the wells that he selected are representative of the Bone 24 Spring. 25 And then the Snee-Zoback excerpt which is

Page 8 his justification for the orientation of the well in this 1 2 area. 3 I think I'll stop there and ask that the 4 exhibits in Case No. 21438 be accepted into the record and that this case be taken under advisement. 5 б HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you, 7 Ms. Bennett. 8 Mr. Lowe, do you have questions? EXAMINER LOWE: No, I do not at this time. 9 Thank you. 10 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 11 12 The exhibits are accepted and Matter 21438 is taken under 13 advisement. MS. BENNETT: Thank you, Madam Examiner. 14 15 With that I'll turn to Case No. 21441, 16 which is also a Bone Spring well. This well, though, is in the west half/west half of Sections 1 and 12, Township 17 26 South, Range 35 East, in Lea County 18 This packet contains the same materials. 19 Behind Tab B are the exhibits prepared by the landman, 20 21 Shelley Albrecht, including the lease tract map, unit 22 recapitulation, summary of contacts, proposal letter and AFEs, and my Notice affidavit. 23 24 And then Tab C has the exhibits of the 25 geologist. And again there we have the locator map, the

Page 9 Gun Barrel, the structure map, the cross reference wells 1 2 that Mr. Kessel used, the cross section that he prepared 3 based on those wells, an isopach, and the excerpt from the 4 Snee-Zoback paper providing his justification for the orientation of the well. 5 If there are no questions about this 6 7 packet, I would ask that the exhibits in Case No. 21441 be 8 admitted into the record and that this case be taken under advisement. 9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you, 10 11 Ms. Bennett. 12 Mr. Rodriguez, I forgot to call on you in 13 connection with the last packet. Did you have any questions about Matter 21438 or 21441? 14 15 MR. RODRIGUEZ: No questions, Madam Examiner. 16 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. 17 Mr. Lowe, do you have questions around 18 21441? 19 EXAMINER LOWE: No, I do not. Thank you. 20 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you. 21 The exhibits are admitted and the matter is taken under advisement. 22 23 MS. BENNETT: Thank you, Madam Examiner. I'll 24 now turn to Case No. 21443, which is the Judge Baylor Fed. 25 Com 701H well, and this is a Wolfcamp well.

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And in this case Franklin Mountain Energy seeks to pool interests underlying the west half/west half of Sections 1 and 12, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. Again this is a standard spacing unit.

In this packet, like the other two packets 6 7 I just discussed, we have Exhibit B, which is the 8 affidavit of the landman Shelley Albrecht, and behind her Exhibit B are the land -- excuse me the land exhibits, 9 including the lease tract map and unit recapitulation. 10 Ιt also includes a Summary of Contacts, the Proposal Letter, 11 12 AFE, C-102. And then behind all of that is my 13 affidavit showing that Notice was timely provided Exhibit C contains the affidavit of the 14 15 qeologist as well as his geology study, which includes a 16 locator map, a gun barrel view of the development plan. It also includes his geology study for this particular 17 well, which includes a structure map, a map showing the 18 cross section wells that he used, which he testifies are 19 representative of the Wolfcamp in this area, the logs and 20 21 cross section that he prepared from the wells, as well as 22 isopach or isocore.

And finally he includes an excerpt from the Snee-Zoback paper which provides the basis for his justification for the orientation of the well.

Page 11 1 I forgot to mention that each of these 2 packets also includes a list of the parties Franklin 3 Mountain Energy is seeking to pool in these matters. With that, Madam Examiner, I will stand for 4 questions but I also ask that the exhibits in Case No. 5 21443 be admitted into the record and that case 21443 be б 7 taken under advisement. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: 8 Thank you, Ms. 9 Bennett. Mr. Rodriguez, did you have any questions 10 11 around 21443? MR. RODRIGUEZ: No questions, Madam Examiner. 12 13 HEARING ORTH: Thank you. 14 Mr. Lowe. 15 EXAMINER LOWE: I have -- I just went to the 16 exhibits super fast, what I'm trying to look at here. 17 Uhm, on your -- your exhibits, page 11 which is indicated as B-1, which is basically your -- the 18 19 one I'm looking at is your Bone Springs unit and your Wolfcamp unit. Just for clarification on my end, that 20 21 area in white which is the -- appears to be, I'm assuming 22 80 acres, --23 MS. BENNETT: Uh-huh. 24 EXAMINER LOWE: -- is that area being excluded? 25 Is that what you're indicating there?

Page 12 MS. BENNETT: No, that area is not being 1 2 That is just to indicate that Franklin Mountain excluded. 3 does not have a leasehold interest in those 80 acres but 4 they are seeking to pool those, that acreage. But that's the subject of the cases that went on October 8th. 5 б EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. All right. 7 Another question, more like a request. In your exhibits, when you submit them, can you -- are you 8 able to add marks or bookmark your exhibits so it will be 9 easier to, when you reference Exhibit A, Exhibit B, C, 10 whatever, that they are easily bookmarked? Is that 11 12 something that you can do? 13 MS. BENNETT: I could definitely give that a 14 shot. I'm always happy to make our exhibits in any way 15 easier to work through, especially in these digital times, 16 so I'm happy to give that a shot. 17 And what you're asking, just so I'm clear, Mr. Lowe, is that if I mention Exhibit A you could just 18 19 click on a bookmark that would take you directly to Exhibit A --20 21 EXAMINER LOWE: Yes. 22 MS. BENNETT: -- or Exhibit B or Exhibit C. 23 EXAMINER LOWE: Yes. 24 MS. BENNETT: I'm sure I can do that. Well, I'm 25 not sure but I'm sure I'll try.

Page 13 EXAMINER LOWE: All right. That's all the questions I have. Thank you. MS. BENNETT: Thank you. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Lowe and Ms. Bennett. Your exhibits are admitted and the matter of 21443 is taken under advisement. MS. BENNETT: Thank you very much. (Time noted 8:33 a.m.)
