Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's go to Case 21534. 2 The applicant is Devon Energy Production LP. These are compulsory pooling applications. The well name is Blondie. 3 4 Who is here from Holland & Hart on behalf of the applicant? 5 MS. LUCK: Hi, again. Kaitlyn Luck with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on behalf of the applicant 6 7 in this case which is Devon Energy Production Company LP. 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. I saw no other entries of appearance in the file. Let me pause for a 9 10 moment and ask if there are any entries. (No audible response.) 11 12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Hearing nothing, if you 13 would proceed, Ms. Luck. 14 MS. LUCK: Thank you, in this case there was an understanding there was no objection to the case proceeding 15 by affidavit, so on Tuesday Devon filed its exhibits with 16 the Division. 17 The exhibit package includes the standard 18 exhibits required by the Division for a pooling hearing, 19 starting off with Exhibit A which is the compulsory pooling 20 application checklist, and then Exhibit B which is a copy of 21 the application filed by Devon in this case for pooling in 22 Lea County, New Mexico. 23 24 Next is Devon's Exhibit C which is the affidavit 25 of Tim Prout who is the landman in this case. He testified

Page 4 that Devon is seeking approval of a standard 480 acre 1 2 spacing unit in the Wolfcamp Formation. The pool code here is 98105, and the spacing unit is located in the W/2 of 3 4 Section 10 and the NW/4 of Section 15, in Township 26 South, Range 34 East in Lea County, New Mexico. 5 6 The spacing unit is going to be dedicated to the 7 Blondie 15-10 Fed Com wells, and the details of each of 8 those wells are provided in both the checklist and the 9 landman's affidavit which includes the C-102s as 10 attachments. I also want to note that in the next case Devon 11 12 has noted that either the 2H well or the 5H well will be the 13 proximity well that pools the proximity tracts in this case 14 which are -- excuse me -- these two wells are located 15 within 330 feet of the E/2 -- excuse me -- of the E/2 W/2 from the W/2 W/2 of Section 10 and the E/2 of the NW/4 from 16 the N/2 of the NW/4 of Section 15. 17 Moving on to the other exhibits that are attached 18 with the landman's affidavit, he includes the standard tract 19 and unit recap, as well as a well proposal letter attaching 20 a copy of the AFEs for each of the wells. He also provides 21 a chronology of his contacts of the uncommitted interest 22 23 owners. 24 Next Devon's Exhibit E is the affidavit of Russel 25 Goodin who is the geologist on this case, and he testifies

Page 5 that the proposed spacing unit is appropriate for horizontal 1 wells in this case. 2 And then finally Devon provides Exhibit E and F 3 4 which show that notice of this hearing was provided to each 5 of the interest owners that Devon seeks to pool in this case 6 both by mail and through a notice of publication in the newspaper where the wells are located. 7 8 So with that, I would move the admission of 9 Devon's Exhibits A through F and request that this case be taken under advisement. 10 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms. Luck. 11 Mr. 12 Lamkin, do you have any questions of Ms. Luck? 13 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LAMKIN: No, ma'am, I do not. 14 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Ms. Luck, 15 Exhibits A through F are admitted, and 21534 is taken under advisement. 16 17 MS. LUCK: Thank you. (Exhibits admitted.) 18 (Taken under advisement.) 19 20 21 22 23 2.4 25
