2 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think we have one  
3 more Spur Energy case here, No. 13 on the list, 21588, the  
4 Trudy wells.

5 MS. BROGGI: Yes. Thank you, Mr. Examiner.

6 Once again Julia Broggi with the Holland &  
7 Hart law firm on behalf of Applicant Spur Energy Partners.

8 And this is just a single case, actually  
9 pretty straightforward compulsory pooling case in this  
10 instance.

11 With that Application in Case No. 21588,  
12 Spur Energy is seeking to pool all of the uncommitted  
13 interests in the Yeso Formation underlying a standard  
14 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the East  
15 Half of Section 7, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM,  
16 Eddy County, New Mexico.

17 No depth severances in this one.

18 Once again you should have received an  
19 exhibit packet on behalf of Spur Energy with a Table of  
20 Contents up at the front.

21 Exhibit A, as always is the Compulsory  
22 Pooling Application.

23 Exhibit B is the application in this single  
24 case.

25 Exhibit C is an affidavit from the landman

2                     Exhibit D is an affidavit from the  
3     geologist the corresponding geology exhibits.

4                     Exhibit E is the affidavit signed by  
5     Kaitlyn Luck of my office showing that Notice of this  
6     hearing was provided to all interested parties.

7                     Let me just double check here.

8                     My understanding is again that all parties  
9     were locatable, but, as you know, out of an abundance of  
10    caution we like to provide Notice of Publication, and we  
11    did in this case and you can find the Affidavit of  
12    Publication at Spur Exhibit F.

13                    And at this point we would move the  
14    admission of Spur Exhibits A through Exhibit F.

15                    HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And  
16    these are the same witnesses?

17                    MS. BROGGI: Once again the same geologist and  
18    same landman, yes.

19                    HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And are  
20    there any other parties? I forgot to ask for entries of  
21    appearances earlier.

22                    Anyone else interested in this matter or  
23    interested in giving comments?

24                    Hearing none, I'll proceed to the technical  
25    examiners for their questions.

1 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: No questions from me.

2 EXAMINER McCLURE: No questions from me.

3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Hearing none,  
4 then we will take -- admit the exhibits in Case 21588 and  
5 take the case under advisement.

6 And I think we are done for the rock and  
7 roll.

8 Disappointed there was no Linkin Park. You  
9 know.

10 MS. BROGGI: If you hang around long enough,  
11 there might be.
