ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

THIS MATTER came before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission (“Commission”) on the joint request of the Parties to dismiss this matter and that the Commission vacate Order No. R-21308 entered on April 20, 2020, with such request filed by COG Operating, LLC. All parties concurring and the Chair of the Commission being otherwise fully advised, finds that the Motion is well-taken and is hereby GRANTED.

On January 25, 2021, COG Operating LLC submitted a Motion to Dismiss Case No. 21321, but did not submit approval of the Motion by opposing counsel, which generated dismissal Order No. R-21308-C. On February 5, 2021, the Parties jointly requested that the Case No. 21321 (Division Case Nos. 20923, 20924, 20925 and 20926) be dismissed due to settlement between the Parties and that Commission Order No. R-21308 be vacated on the same grounds.

Commission Order No. R-21308 is hereby VACATED and the Commission’s prior DISMISSAL of this action, dated January 27, 2021, remains in effect.
