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Page 3 1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. With that, we 2 can move on to case Number 21589, Texas Standard, and it's the Alpha Dog, James Bruce. 3 MR. BRUCE: Yes, I'm entering an appearance on 4 5 Texas Standard's behalf in that case and the four -- the 6 three other succeeding cases. 7 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. So it's 21589, 21590, 591, 592. Are you looking to have those all 8 9 consolidated, Mr. Bruce? MR. BRUCE: Yes. 10 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. And it looks 11 like we have Manzano. Mr. Padilla, are you --12 13 MR. PADILLA: I'm entering an appearance for Manzano, and, Mr. Examiner, those cases should be combined 14 with cases on the second page, Cases 33, 34, 35, 36, 37 --15 16 yes. 17 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Are you starting with -- which numbers are you starting with, Number 33, 18 19 21514? 20 MR. PADILLA: Correct. 21514 through 21517. 21 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. And you're not 22 including 21513; is that correct? 23 MR. PADILLA: Yeah, I'm including that one as 24 well. 25 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. So I have, if

Page 4 my addition is correct, six cases then. 1 MR. PADILLA: Right. 2 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Combined with four 3 4 cases from Texas Standard. Mr. Bruce, is that acceptable? 5 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 6 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: All right. Well, 7 let's look to see other parties then. It appears on cases 8 32 through 37, 21513 through 21517, we have a few other 9 parties here. Is Holland & Hart appearing at all in these 10 cases? MR. PADILLA: No, Your Honor. I took over these 11 cases for Holland & Hart. 12 13 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you for 14 clarifying that. 15 MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. This is Deana Bennett on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian LLC, and 16 Marathon Oil Permian LLC is in the Manzano cases 32 through 17 18 37 on the docket. Thank you. HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. And do you have 19 any objection to combining those with the Texas Standard 20 21 cases? 22 MS. BENNETT: No objection. 23 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: All right. Are there 24 any other appearances in these cases? I believe there's ten 25 of them now.

Page 5 1 (No audible response.) 2 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Hearing none, that's 3 simple, we are down to three parties. So are these 4 overlapping applications? 5 MR. PADILLA: Yes. Yes, they are, Mr. Examiner. 6 But, you know, we filed a -- Mr. Bruce actually filed it --7 a motion to vacate the status conference for the setting for 8 today based on agreement between Texas Standard and Manzano 9 LLC. 10 They were supposed to close yesterday and the -and Mr. Bruce's motion is designed to allow a future setting 11 12 of the status conference in the event that they don't 13 ultimately close, and I don't know what Marathon's position 14 would be on that. HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Well, let's start with 15 Manzano's position on that. Mr. Padilla? 16 17 MR. PADILLA: As far as we're concerned, and I haven't gotten word from my client, that if -- that Manzano 18 has bought out Texas Standard, and they were supposed to 19 close yesterday. I haven't heard from my client whether 20 they did or not, but as far as I'm concerned, or at least 21 what my knowledge is is that it's a done deal. Mr. Bruce 22 23 may have additional comments on that. 24 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Mr. Bruce, your 25 motion.

Page 6 MR. BRUCE: I agree, I agree with Mr. Padilla. 1 The parties agreed to a settlement about seven or eight days 2 ago, and they were supposed to close yesterday. I haven't 3 4 heard back anything good, bad or otherwise. And I do have an e-mail in to my client. They do want a short -- I think 5 6 both parties want a short continuance of this matter. They believe -- I think there is two things. 7 They were pretty darn sure they were going to settle, and at 8 that point all of these cases could be dismissed. And if it 9 10 can't be, Manzano has certain deadlines it has to meet, so it does not want a long continuance. I think that's 11 12 correct, is it not, Mr. Padilla? 13 MR. PADILLA: Yeah, that's correct. 14 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. I will turn 15 this over to Ms. Bennett. MS. BENNETT: Thank you, Mr. Examiner, Marathon 16 17 does not object to a short continuance or a long continuance, whatever the parties -- whatever Manzano and 18 19 Texas Standard are -- yeah -- whatever, I forget now, agree to is fine with Marathon. 20 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: You are the Alpha Dog. 21 Mr. Padilla is the Vindicator. By short continuance, I 22 23 assume you mean our next hearing date; is that correct? 24 MR. BRUCE: That is what I requested in the 25 motion, and we will be able to hopefully get word in the

Page 7 next day or so, Mr. Padilla and I get word, and really, at 1 2 that time, we could -- we would just send in a dismissal. 3 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. I will turn to 4 my betters here, Ms. Murphy and Marlene and find out if that's okay for us to this add on to the next agenda? 5 6 TECHNICAL EXAMINER MURPHY: That would be 7 Marlene's decision. 8 MS. SALVIDREZ: You want me to continue these to 9 February 4? 10 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: That's the question. That's the next hearing; correct? 11 12 MS. SALVIDREZ: Yes. 13 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Is that okay? Can we 14 do that? 15 MS. SALVIDREZ: I suppose so, yeah. I will move them to February 4, and I just want to clarify, there is 16 17 only nine cases; correct? There was nine and then I heard 18 someone say ten cases, so --HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Yeah, because -- I 19 think there is six Manzano cases. Is that correct, Mr. 20 21 Padilla? 22 MR. PADILLA: That's correct, and there's four 23 Texas Standard. 24 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Four Texas Standard. 25 So it's on our docket today, Marlene. It's Cases 17 through

So I have them correct, I'm going to move Cases 21589, 21590, 21591, 21592, 21513, 3 4 514, 515, 516 and 517 to February 4? 5 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Correct. I think 6 there was a 518 in there, too. 7 MS. SALVIDREZ: So there are ten cases. 8 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Yes. 9 MS. SALVIDREZ: Am I going to move them as a 10 status conference or --HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Status conference. 11 12 MS. SALVIDREZ: Okay, thank you. All right. Are 13 there any other further comments on this grouping of cases? 14 MR. PADILLA: Not from me. 15 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Hearing none, these ten cases, which Ms. Salvidrez listed so carefully, will be 16 moved to the next docket, February 4. Thank you. 17 18 MR.
