1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: We will proceed to the

- 2 next four cases, 21638, 21639, 21640 and 21641. The
- 3 applicant in each case is Apache Corporation. Each of the
- 4 applications seeks an amendment to an order. The well name
- 5 is Camacho, and I believe I see Mr. Hough from Modrall
- 6 Sperling.
- 7 MR. HOUGH: That's correct, Madam Examiner.
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let me pause for a moment
- 9 in the event there are any other entries of appearance.
- 10 (No audible response.)
- 11 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: I don't hear anything.
- 12 If you would, please, Mr. Hough.
- 13 MR. HOUGH: I would like to present these as
- 14 consolidated. These are applications to amend orders on the
- 15 listing here 21 -- orders R-21181, R-21138, R-21139 and
- 16 R-21140.
- 17 The first one, Case 21638 in order 21181, point
- 18 of clarification here, this is an application for amending
- 19 the order for extension of one year for the drilling. One
- 20 point of clarification I wanted to make is the application
- 21 originally included two requested forms of relief; one, an
- 22 amendment of the order to the updated form of order as
- 23 previously -- the other three orders were previously under a
- 24 prior form of order. This one was entered a little bit
- 25 later, so that was initially requested in the initial

1 relief, however the factual content of the remainder of the

- 2 application are specific to this form so that the initial
- 3 sentence is superfluous. The order is under the current
- 4 form, so I just wanted to make that one point of
- 5 clarification for that first order so there is no confusion
- 6 there.
- 7 As I was saying, on the first order, 21181,
- 8 Apache is seeking an extension of one year to the drilling
- 9 schedule. For the remaining three orders, 21138, 21139 and
- 10 21140, Apache is seeking these forms of order to be updated
- 11 to the amended form of order and allow for an extension of
- 12 one year for the time to commence drilling operations.
- 13 In support of that, the landman involved, Blake
- 14 Johnson here has provided that good cause exists for the
- 15 extension of time because due to the current market
- 16 conditions and Covid-19 matters, Apache has had to adjust
- 17 its drilling schedule for this development. And again,
- 18 these are for the Camacho wells.
- 19 Provided in the application here is Exhibit A.
- 20 That is the self-affirmed declaration of Blake Johnson who
- 21 previously testified before the Division.
- 22 A-1 through 4 are the applications.
- 23 A-5 is the April 2, 2020 letter, an amended order
- 24 template that was previously provided by the Division to
- 25 update the prior temporary form of order. Again, that's

1 critical to the last three of these orders R-21138 through

- 2 R-21140.
- A-6 through A-9 are the orders themselves, and
- 4 Exhibit B is an affidavit from myself with respect to
- 5 notice.
- As you see there are attachments of B-1, B-2,
- 7 B-3. Notice was timely sent on January 15, and then we also
- 8 published notice in newspaper of local circulation timely as
- 9 well on January 19.
- 10 So with that, if the Division has any questions,
- 11 I would asked that these exhibits be accepted into the
- 12 record and this matter be taken under advisement.
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Hough.
- 14 The exhibits are accepted. Let me ask Mr. Simmons if he has
- 15 any questions.
- 16 TECHNICAL EXAMINER SIMMONS: No, everything
- 17 appears to be in good order. Thank you.
- 18 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you
- 19 very much. Thank you, Mr. Hough. Matters will be taken
- 20 under advisement.
