Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let's move then to 21615 2 and 21616, Titus Oil and Gas is the applicant, compulsory pooling application. Chicken Noodle is the name of the 3 4 well. Ms. Shaheen, is that you from Montgomery and Andrews 5 for the applicant? 6 MS. SHAHEEN: It is. Good morning, Madam 7 Examiner. 8 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Good morning. I didn't 9 see any other entries in the case file, so let me pause for 10 a moment in the event there is an entry this morning. (No audible response.) 11 12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: No? If you would, please 13 qo ahead. 14 MS. SHAHEEN: Thank you. In these two cases, 15 which I would like to consolidate 21615 and 21616, Titus seeks to pool the W/2 of Section 2 and the NW/4 of Section 16 17 11 in Township 26 South and Range 25 East in Eddy County. In 21615 they seek to pool a 480 acre unit, and 18 propose to drill one well at this time, and that is a Bone 19 Spring well, the 30 -- the Chicken Noodle Fed Com 301H. 20 Ι think it's slightly atypical in that we've included 21 proximity tracts because they propose to drill this well 22 23 straight down the middle of the quarter section, so we have 24 included six proximity tracts. 25 And the ownership of all tracts is the same. In

lease. And in Tract 2, COG and LR own a federal lease, and
as I said, the ownership across the quarter-quarter sections
within that quarter section is the same, and everyone was
noticed that we are including in these proximity tracts.

6 If you take a look at .pdf Page 2, you will see 7 our table of contents that illustrates how we've organized 8 the requisite exhibits.

9 Moving on to case 21616, the Fed Com, these are 10 Wolfcamp wells, they will be drilled in the Wolfcamp XY, and 11 they do have non-standard locations and we originally sought 12 to have approval of those non-standard locations heard at 13 this hearing.

But since that time we've, we received administrative approval of those non-standard locations, and the landman's affidavit identifies the administrative orders that approve those non-standard locations.

If, if anyone is interested, in .pdf Page 20 in 18 the landman's affidavit, Titus' landman, his testimony has 19 been previously admitted in other applications and hearings. 20 He explains why they decided to drill the Bone Spring well 21 down the middle of the quarter section, and it is because 22 23 the Wolfcamp XY and the Third Bone Spring are likely part of 24 the same flow unit. And Titus believes that the three wells 25 in the flow unit within the horizontal spacing unit is the

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proper development based on their modeling and monitoring of 1 2 nearby wells. I think I hit the main points here, and I would 3 4 ask that the exhibits be admitted into the record and the case be taken under advisement subject to any questions that 5 6 Mr. Lowe may have. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: All right. Thank you, 7 8 Ms. Shaheen. The exhibits are admitted. Mr. Lowe, do you have questions of Ms. Shaheen? 9 10 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: Yes, I have one, Ms. Shaheen. You reference that a few of the wells or all of 11 those wells that you mentioned have an approved NSL? 12 13 MS. SHAHEEN: The Bone Spring well is within 14 standard setbacks. The two Wolfcamp wells, 401H and 402H, 15 we do have two orders approving the non-standard locations for the Wolfcamp wells. 16 17 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. And just to reiterate, all of those NSLs are done administratively, so 18 it's only brought to hearing if it's contested and any 19 resolution cannot be determined at an administrative level. 20 Just reminding you. 21 22 MS. SHAHEEN: Thank you so much, and I appreciate that because I meant to ask that the Division dismiss that 23 24 portion of application that seeks approval of the 25 non-standard location in this application.

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Page 6 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. That's all I have, thank you. MS. SHAHEEN: Thank you. HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Mr. Lowe and Ms. Shaheen. The matter is taken under advisement. б (Exhibits admitted.) (Taken under advisement.)
