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**APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

In **Case No. 21738**, Matador seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation (Avalon; Bone Spring, East (3713)) underlying a standard 317.32-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Sections 29 and 30, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The spacing unit will be dedicated to the following proposed initial wells:

- **Leatherneck 3029 Fed Com #127H well** (API No. 30-015-46894), which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Lot 4) of Section 30 to bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 29; and
- **Leatherneck 3029 Fed Com #137H well** (API No. 30-015-46895), which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Lot 3) of Section 30 to bottom hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 29.

The completed interval for these wells will comply with the standard setbacks required by the statewide rules set forth in 19.15.16.15 NMAC.

In **Case No. 21739**, Matador seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation (Avalon; Bone Spring, East (3713)) underlying a standard 317.32-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Sections 29 and 30, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The spacing unit will be dedicated to the following proposed initial wells:

- **Leatherneck 3029 Fed Com #128H well** (API No. 30-015-46903), which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Lot 4) of Section 30 to bottom hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 29; and
- **Leatherneck 3029 Fed Com #138H well** (API No. 30-015-46896), which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Lot 3) of Section 30 to bottom hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 29.

The completed interval for these wells will comply with the standard setbacks required by the statewide rules set forth in 19.15.16.15 NMAC.
