Commissioners,

Geolex, Incorporated® (Geolex), on behalf of 3Bear Field Services, LLC (3Bear) is requesting a one-time extension of NMOCC Order No. R-20694 to adequate time for the drilling and completion of the Libby Berry AGI No. 1 injection well.

Similar to many operators of New Mexico assets, COVID-19 pandemic uncertainties have necessitated careful prioritization of on-going projects and resulted in the delay of 3Bear's efforts to construct this well. That being said, the proposed Libby Berry AGI No. 1 remains an component to 3Bears operations in New Mexico and, as such, 3Bear is fully committed to drill and complete this well.

Presently, 3Bear is working to finalize and fulfill air-permitting requirements for the gas facility and finalize the design of the proposed amine treatment system that will be utilized at the subject facility. Significant progress is being made with respect to these tasks, however, additional time will ultimately be needed plan and complete drilling operations for the Libby Berry AGI well(s). As such, we respectfully request a one-time extension to NMOCC Order No. R-20694 for a period of two (2) years to allow sufficient time to get the subject AGI well drilled, completed, and commissioned.
