For the Applicant:

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1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: We will move then to Case
2 21332, applicant Riley Permian Operating, it's a compulsory
3 pooling matter. The well name is Torino.

4 Is that you, Ms. Hardy?

5 MS. HARDY: (Inaudible.) Can you hear me?

6 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Yes, now I can hear you.

7 MS. HARDY: Thank you. Dana Hardy on behalf of
8 Riley Permian Operating Company LLC.

9 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Let me pause a moment to
10 see if there are any other appearances.

11 (No audible response.)

12 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: No? Please go ahead.

13 MS. HARDY: Thank you. Riley seeks an order
14 pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in a 240 acre more
15 or less standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the
16 W/2 of the W/2 of Section 4, Township 9 South, Range 34 East
17 in Lea County, and the W/2 of the SW/4 of Section 33,
18 Township 8 South, Range 34 East in Roosevelt County.

19 Included in your exhibit packet are the
20 self-affirmed statements of landman Ty Edelen, and geologist
21 Daniel Osborn. Neither witness has testified previously
22 before the division and statements of their qualifications
23 are provided as Exhibit A-2 and B-1.

24 Riley has complied with the division's notice
25 requirements and provided notice by publication and also by

1 certified mail. The hearing notice and certified mail
2 receipts are attached to Mr. Edelen's affidavit as Exhibit
3 A-9, and the affidavits of publication are attached as
4 Exhibit A-10, and we did publish notice in both Lea and
5 Roosevelt counties.

6 So with that, unless there are questions, I would
7 ask that the statements be accepted as expert testimony,
8 that the exhibits be admitted into the record, and that the
9 case be taken under advisement.

10 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you, Ms. Hardy.
11 Let me ask Mr. Rose Coss, do you have questions of Ms.
12 Hardy?

13 TECHNICAL EXAMINER COSS: (Garbled audio.) Thank
14 you for submitting the exhibits timely with the compulsory
15 pooling application checklist complete. I would only ask
16 that by -- did the packet include any documentation that
17 written evidence was given to all the parties to seek a
18 voluntary agreement concerning good-faith efforts to make it
19 a voluntary agreement in the compulsory pooling?

20 MS. HARDY: Yes. I think Mr. Edelen's affidavit
21 states the parties were contacted and that Riley made a good
22 faith effort to work with them before pooling.

23 TECHNICAL EXAMINER COSS: Perfect. Well, that
24 (garbled audio). I appreciate. Those are all my questions.
25 Thank you.

1 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Mr. Lowe, do
2 you have any questions of Ms. Hardy?

3 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: I just have a quick
4 question, can you state again what pool that this is
5 pertaining to?

6 MS. HARDY: The pool is --

7 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: I can't -- I haven't
8 had a chance to read your exhibits yet.

9 MS. HARDY: Sure. It's DLR San Andres Code
10 12450.

11 TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: 12450, okay, that's all
12 I have for now. Thank you.

13 MS. HARDY: Thank you.

14 HEARING EXAMINER ORTH: Thank you. Thank you,
15 Ms. Hardy. Your witnesses' testimony is accepted, the
16 exhibits are accepted and matter will be taken under
17 advisement.
