The Jicarilla Apache Nation Oil and Gas Administration is vested with the overall responsibility to manage the Jicarilla Nation oil and gas mineral resources and in review of Black Hills Gas Resources, Inc. proposal has determined it to be in the best interest of the Jicarilla Nation to support the application and proposal from Black Hills Corporation, through its subsidiary, Black Hills Gas Resources, Inc., for the creation of the proposed Jicarilla Mancos Development Area.

Black Hills has been operating on the Jicarilla Apache Nation Lands since 2003. Black Hills Gas Resources, Inc. through its affiliation with the Jicarilla Apache Nation as a partner in the Mineral Development Agreement (MDA) has proven to be prudent in its drilling and development program. As a joint working partner, the proposed Jicarilla (Mancos Formation) Project Area will protect the correlative rights of the Jicarilla Apache Nation lands while minimizing additional surface disturbance will result in greater ultimate recovery of the natural gas resources of the Nation.

Upon review of this matter in detail, the Jicarilla Apache Nation Oil and Gas Administration is in agreement with the proposed Black Hills Gas Resources, Inc., request for the creation of the Jicarilla Mancos Development Area and hereby submits this recommendation for Approval.
