4 I'm calling Cases 20309, 20310, 20344,
5 20345, 20346, and 20347 and 20424.

6 Let's start with Marathon Oil Permian, LLC.

7 MS. BRADFUTE: Mr. Examiner, this is Jennifer
8 Bradfute with Marathon Oil Company on behalf of Marathon
9 Permian, LLC.

10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. EOG Resources.

11 MS. LUCK: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Kaitlyn
12 Luck with the Santa Fe Office of Holland & Hart for EOG
13 Resources.

14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: And I don't have any other
15 parties listed. Are there any other interested parties in
16 these seven cases? (Note: Pause.)

17 Hearing none. Well, we are two-and-a-half
18 years into these cases. My boss, you know, wants me to
19 dismiss cases that hang around too long. So why don't we
20 give it one more try.

21 Thank you, actually, for the Status Report.
22 I really appreciate that. That was very helpful.

23 So you suggested February. We don't even
24 have dates in February yet.

25 So, Marlene, do we have dates in January?

1 MS. SALVIDREZ: Yes. We have January 6th and
2 January 20th.

3 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So any issues
4 with either of those dates, Ms. Bradfute?

5 MS. BRADFUTE: No, Mr. Examiner. We would
6 prefer the January 20th date, but the parties did touch
7 base with Marathon's land department, who has been in
8 communication with EOG's land department, and they felt
9 like the deal would be finalized in January, so I think
10 February was requested for a little comfort to make sure
11 we have things finalized.

12 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Ms. Luck, any issues
13 with dates?

14 MS. LUCK: January 20th works for EOG, too. I
15 agree with Ms. Bradfute's comments about just putting the
16 cases out as far as possible, so we'll go with January
17 20th at this point.

18 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. We will set
19 these cases for January 20th. That means you're coming up
20 on the three-year anniversary. And I know you would like
21 to have us here with cake and everything to celebrate, but
22 at that point, you know, if you're not done you're out of
23 here. Okay?

24 So fair warning. Try to get this resolved
25 or set a hearing date. Thank you.

1 So these Cases 20309, 20310, 20344, -345
2 -346, -347 and 20424 are continued to January 20th.

3 Do you want this set for a status
4 conference on that date?

5 MS. BRADFUTE: Yes, Mr. Examiner.

6 MS. LUCK: Yes, please.

8 Scheduling Order. Thank you.
