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Page 4 1 (Time noted 10:02 a.m.) 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Cases 22142, Devon Energy 3 Production. 4 MR. SAVAGE: Yes, Mr. Hearing Examiner. This is Darin Savage on behalf of Devon Energy Production Company, 5 б L.P. 7 Let me pull this case up real quick. Ι apologize for the delay here. I thought I had this one up 8 on my computer. 9 EXAMINER BRANCARD: I'm going to ask if there 10 are any other interested persons for Case 22142. 11 12 MR. SAVAGE: Okav. 13 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, are you ready 14 to go, Mr. Savage, or should we take a break? 15 MR. SAVAGE: No, this is good. 16 We are representing Case 22142, which 17 covers the lands in the east half of Sections 15 and 22, Township 25 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. 18 This case is without objection and with the 19 Division's consent we plan to proceed by affidavit. 20 21 The landman, Verl Brown for these cases has testified before the Division and this credentials have 22 been accepted and a made a matter of record. 23 24 The geologist is Kate Hughston-Kennedy. 25 She has not testified previously before the Division. She

Page 5 has worked as a petroleum geologist for Devon since 2013, 1 2 received her Bachelor's in geology from Texas A&M. She 3 has published on the characteristics of New Mexico's 4 Delaware Basin and has provided a one-page resume for your 5 review in her Exhibit B. I tender Ms. Hughston-Kennedy as б and expert witness in geology. 7 In this Case No. 22142, Devon seeks an order creating a standard 640-acre spacing unit covering 8 the east half of Sections 15 and 22 and pooling all 9 uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp Formation designated 10 as a Gas Pool. 11 12 The unit has dedicated the four wells, the Shire 22-15 Fed Com 613H well, the Shire 22-15 Fed Com 618 13 well, the Shire 22-15 Fed Com 718 well, and the Shire 14 22-15 Fed Com 733H. 15 16 Orientation of the wells are standup, south 17 to north. And they do have a nonstandard location but have been approved administratively by the Division. 18 Mr. Brown's' Exhibit A for Case 22142 19 includes his landman's affidavit, C-102s, ownership 20 21 breakdown, Well Proposal with AFEs, and a Chronology of 22 Contacts showing good faith negotiations. 23 The working interest owners have committed 24 their interests to this unit by voluntary agreement and 25 this application is presented for the purpose of pooling

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1 the overriding royalty interest owners.

2 Ms. Hughston-Kennedy's Exhibit B for this 3 case includes her geology affidavit, along with the five 4 standard geology exhibits showing good potential for 5 development. Exhibit C provides the Affidavit of Notice 6 7 of for mailings and Publication Notice. Notice was timely Two parties were unlocatable as Devon received 8 sent. Return Mailings for Barry Eugene Bryant and Eva Mendoza 9 Bryant. Five mailing are listed as still in transit. 10 Devon timely published Notice to account for any 11 12 unlocatable parties or such contingencies. 13 Both Mr. Brown and Ms. Hughston-Kennedy 14 affirm that the approval of this application is in the 15 best interest of conservation, protection of correlative 16 rights and prevention of waste, and will prevent the 17 drilling of unnecessary wells. 18 Mr. Examiner, at this point I move that Exhibits A, B and C, and all sub exhibits be admitted into 19 the record for Case 21142, and that this case be taken 20 21 under advisement. 22 I stand available for any questions 23 regarding this case. 24 EXAMINER BRANCARD: THANK you. 25 Mr. Simmons.

Page 7 MR. SIMMONS: Did I hear mention about a 1 2 nonstandard location? 3 MR. SAVAGE: Yes. This is in the Purple Sage Wolfcamp and the take points, they are 100 feet from the 4 5 outer boundary. But we have already applied and have received approval from the Division for those locations. б 7 EXAMINER SIMMONS: Okay. Good. No other questions. Thank you. We will contact you if anything 8 does come up for our consideration. 9 10 MR. SAVAGE: Okay. Thank you for your 11 consideration. 12 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Savage, I thought when I 13 saw the applications these were only overriding royalty 14 interests. 15 MR. SAVAGE: Yes. We were able to receive voluntary agreements and a JOA for the working interest 16 17 owners, and we had a number of overriding royalty interest owners. We wanted to make sure that they were accounted 18 for. There's a number of them. 19 I guess the other option would be to ratify 20 21 the CA, but we just want to make sure everything was in 22 place. 23 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. So there are no 24 working interests being pooled. 25 MR. SAVAGE: No.

Page 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. We just do a 1 2 slightly different Order in that regard. We don't have to 3 do a lot of the standard stuff, 200 percent and all that. MR. SAVAGE: Right. Yes. Thank you. That's 4 clear. It's overriding royalty interests only. 5 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. So, finally, are б 7 there any other interested persons for Case 22142 today? 8 (Note: Pause.) Hearing none, the exhibits are admitted into the record and Case 22142 will be taken 9 under advisement. 10 11 MR.
