- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: So with that I think we are
- 3 coming to the last and best item on our agenda, Item
- 4 No. 28, Case 22159.
- 5 Mewbourne Oil Company.
- 6 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce representing
- 7 Mewbourne.
- 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And I have an
- 9 Entry of Appearance for MRC Permian.
- 10 MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the examiner,
- 11 Michael Feldewert of the Santa Fe office of Holland and
- 12 Hart.
- 13 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Then I have an entry -- and
- 14 I'm going to get this wrong, Sabinal Energy Operating.
- 15 MR. JONES: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. This is
- 16 Blake Jones with Steptoe & Johnson appearing on behalf of
- 17 Sabinal Energy Operating, LLC.
- 18 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 19 So I guess first, Mr. Feldewert, do you
- 20 have any objections to this case going forward by
- 21 affidavit?
- MR. FELDEWERT: I do not.
- 23 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Jones?
- MR. JONES: Sabinal does not.
- 25 EXAMINER BRANCARD: So are there any other

- 1 interested parties in Case 22159? (Note: Pause.)
- 2 Hearing none, Mr. Bruce let's start with a
- 3 very basic question here that could be the focus of the
- 4 entire discussion today, which is: What is the legal
- 5 description of the unit that you're seeking to pool?
- 6 MR. BRUCE: South half of Section 24 and south
- 7 half of Section 23 in 20 South, 28 East.
- 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: So Township 20 South, Range
- 9 28 East; is that correct?
- 10 MR. BRUCE: That's correct.
- 11 The original Notice that I submitted, the
- 12 landman at Sabinal pointed out to the Division that the
- 13 original Notice that I submitted along with the Pooling
- 14 Application had a different township and range. I have
- 15 corrected that and sent in a correction to Ms. Salvidrez
- 16 containing the proper Notice.
- 17 The Application itself and the Notice that
- 18 went out did contain the correct Township and Range, 20
- 19 South, 28 East.
- 20 EXAMINER BRANCARD: I had time to go through the
- 21 file here, and what I saw in our file was that the Notice
- that we put up for the September 9th hearing, the docket
- 23 for the September 23rd hearing, all listed in Township 23
- 24 South, as apparently did your Prehearing Statement, Mr.
- 25 Bruce.

- 1 MR. BRUCE: Yeah.
- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. You apparently gave
- 3 the wrong Township in the Letters you sent out to owners,
- 4 not to the wrong Range, but you sent second letters out to
- 5 correct that.
- 6 I guess the one that also concerns me the
- 7 most, if I can find it here, is the Publication of Notice
- 8 in the newspaper, which I recall got both the Township and
- 9 the Range wrong.
- 10 MR. BRUCE: I thought I had correctly done that
- 11 one. The Notice Letters that went out did have the
- 12 correct Township.
- 13 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Yes, the Publication in the
- 14 Carlsbad paper, Township 23 South.
- MR. BRUCE: Correct.
- 16 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Range 26 East.
- 17 So I'm just going to say right now that,
- 18 you know, as we have gone through today we have worked
- 19 with the parties and been fairly forgiving of lots of
- 20 little mistakes in applications and submittals, but, you
- 21 know, getting the legal description wrong in a Notice I
- 22 think is something that really is a huge problem. So I'll
- 23 Give you a chance to respond, Mr. Bruce, please.
- MR. BRUCE: Well, I don't have any objection
- 25 about -- I would like to continue it to the next available

1 hearing. I could correct the Publication Notice, which is

- 2 really the only thing that needs to be done. The
- 3 published Notice in the newspaper.
- 4 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Well, and then we need to
- 5 get the right blurb in our docket Notices.
- 6 MR. BRUCE: Yes. And I did send a corrected
- 7 Notice to Marlene.
- 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So I guess -- I guess
- 9 my preference would be if you just filed a whole new
- 10 application. That actually might be easier for you. You
- 11 might get on a quicker docket in some ways if you did
- 12 that. You might even get it for the first November docket
- 13 for that, because otherwise our other dockets are really
- 14 full.
- MR. BRUCE: That would be fine.
- 16 EXAMINER BRANCARD: You have all the materials,
- 17 so -- if you would like to just continue this and correct
- 18 a few things.
- 19 MR. BRUCE: Yeah. Like I said, I have already
- 20 taken care of the Notice, and that was, you know, an
- 21 effort to refile that. And so all it really is, is the
- 22 published Notice in the Carlsbad newspaper, which, based
- on some additional green cards I've gotten back, it
- 24 probably isn't necessary, but what the heck.
- 25 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Yeah. We need to get that

- 1 right.
- 2 So let's look to continue this case, then.
- MR. BRUCE: Well, I mean if you want me to
- 4 file -- I mean if -- you know, nobody is objecting to the
- 5 case. Sabinal is out of it. I think Mewbourne is talking
- 6 with MRC Permian to get their joinder in the well. I
- 7 mean, if you want me to refile for November 2nd, that's
- 8 fine, as long as I know I can get that date; otherwise
- 9 continue it to October 20 -- whatever date that is, 21?
- 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think we have got close to
- 11 100, if not over 100 cases in October.
- MR. BRUCE: So, you know, I do need sufficient
- 13 time. It takes a while to get these Publication
- 14 Notices --
- 15 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Right.
- MR. BRUCE: -- in the paper.
- So if you want me to go for November 2nd,
- 18 if you want me to refile for that date, that's fine, Mr.
- 19 Examiner.
- 20 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Why don't we do that. Why
- 21 don't we just dismiss Case 21896 and then you can refile
- 22 and get it on whenever the quickest docket is.
- 23 MR. BRUCE: It's not 896, it's 159.
- EXAMINER BRANCARD: I'm sorry, 22159.
- MR. BRUCE: Don't scare me. The Notice was too

Page 8 1 onerous in that one. 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So we are going 3 to dismiss Case 22159 without prejudice so you have the ability to refile the case whenever you're ready. 4 MR.
