Page 3 1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So now we have cases 11 through 14, 22144, 22317, Cimarex; 22343 and 344, 2 3 Chevron. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce representing 4 5 Cimarex. 6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And Chevron? 7 MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiner, 8 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland & 9 Hart. 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I believe I have an entry for MRC Permian? 11 12 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Kyle Perkins from MRC 13 Permian entered an appearance. I did get an e-mail from him 14 saying he may be unable to attend this status conference. 15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Are there any other interested parties in Cases 22144, 317, 343, 344? 16 17 (No audible response.) 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing not, where are we going with these? There is a slight connection, I 19 think, to the next group of cases. These are the White City 20 cases I believe you referred to, Mr. Bruce. 21 MR. BRUCE: Yes, Mr. Examiner --22 23 (Overtalk.) 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: -- and you filed a 25 motion to segregate, which they are right now, so unless you

Page 4 have a better idea, I'm treating these as two separate 1 2 groups of cases. MR. BRUCE: Well, let's just start with the --3 4 chevron has filed cases on certain of the acreage in the 5 White City area involving Wolfcamp wells, and Cimarex has filed both Cimarex and Wolfcamp applications, but I believe 6 Chevron will be -- Mr. Feldewert can confirm -- Chevron will 7 8 be filing Bone Spring applications, and I think Cimarex will be filing additional Wolfcamp applications. 9 10 So I don't know like when you're filing your applications, but obviously the cases are not ripe for 11 12 hearing yet. Mr. Feldewert? 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: 14 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes. I mean, things sorted out 15 here a little bit, we basically have some overlap in the acreage, particularly with respect to Section 17 and 20 16 17 where Chevron owns the majority of the interest. We do have currently Wolfcamp well proposals on 18 That's those two cases you have listed, Mr. Examiner, 19 file. 22343 and 344. And they involve the E/2 and the W/2 of this 20 acreage. Chevron has also filed and they will be on the 21 January 6 docket, two mile pooling applications for Bone 22 Spring wells in Section 17 and 20, so they will be on the 23 24 January 6 docket. 25 I don't know what Cimarex's plans are with

respect to the Bone Spring when it comes to the W/2 acreage 1 2 because currently they have an application for the E/2 acreage, and I don't want this delayed any longer than 3 4 necessary. 5 So come January 6, my understanding, all the cases will be on the docket and we should be in a position 6 7 now to set a contested case sometime after January 6. 8 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, yes, it's my job this 9 weekend to file a bunch of applications on the W/2 acreage 10 for Cimarex which Mr. Feldewert discussed. But, yeah, if we could get a setting that would be good. 11 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So are we just 13 talking about these White City cases right now, that 14 acreage? Or is this all going to get jumbled together? 15 MR. FELDEWERT: To jump ahead, Mr. Examiner, to the Southern Hills applications, they will need a hearing 16 date because Chevron does have some questions, some 17 concerns. Chevron will not be filing competing pooling 18 applications, so I don't think it's going to take very long. 19 20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So these are competing? What are the numbers of your cases, Mr. 21 Feldewert, do you know? 22 MR. FELDEWERT: 22343 to 44, and I will send to 23 24 you the cases for the Bone Spring applications that were 25 recently filed.

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Page 6 1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: You don't have that 2 handy. 3 MR. FELDEWERT: No, I do not. 4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: But you would like that combined with these cases? 5 6 MR. FELDEWERT: The Bone Spring and Wolfcamp, 7 yes, because they own both the same acreage. 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And, Mr. Bruce, are you going to file any more cases for this acreage for the 9 10 White City area. MR. BRUCE: Yes, for Wolfcamp wells. 11 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Well, I'm wondering 13 if we need a status conference to sort all of this out or 14 whether we set a hearing out in the future. MR. FELDEWERT: My preference, Mr. Examiner, 15 would be to go ahead and set a hearing. 16 MR. BRUCE: And that's fine with me, too, Mr. 17 Examiner. 18 19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: February 17? 20 MR. FELDEWERT: Give me one minute. 21 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, did you say January 17? 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: No, February 17. MR. BRUCE: February 17, that's fine with me. 23 24 MR. FELDEWERT: That works for me as well, Mr. 25 Examiner.

Page 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I will need to do a 1 2 prehearing order, but it would be helpful to have all the 3 case numbers. 4 MR. FELDEWERT: It's on my list to get that to you, Mr. Examiner. 5 MR. BRUCE: I haven't filed mine yet, so I will б 7 get that to you ASAP. 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So when you file, send a separate piece of paper or send an e-mail about the 9 situation, Mr. Bruce. 10 MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir. 11 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Don't assume we are 13 tracking the filing of new cases and figure out where they 14 are. 15 MR. BRUCE: I can't figure out my own. 16 MR. FELDEWERT: Actually, Mr. Examiner, I can give those to you now. 17 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Excellent. 19 MR. FELDEWERT: I will send you an e-mail, it will be clearer. 20 21 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. With that, Cases 22144, 22317, 343 and 344 are set for a 22 contested hearing on February 17 with the proviso that 23 additional cases will be added on that cover the same 24 25 acreage. I will do a prehearing order. Thank you.
