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1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that, I'm

- 2 calling Item Number 63 on our docket today, Case 22352,
- 3 Chevron USA Inc.
- 4 MS. LUCK: Good morning again. Kaitlyn Luck with
- 5 the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart on behalf of the
- 6 applicant in this case Chevron USA Inc.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there
- 8 any other interested persons for Case 22352?
- 9 (No audible response.)
- 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, you may
- 11 proceed, Ms. Luck.
- 12 MS. LUCK: Thank you. Chevron understood there
- 13 would be no opposition to this case proceeding by affidavit
- 14 today, and so on Tuesday Chevron filed its exhibit with the
- 15 Division.
- 16 The exhibit packet includes all of the standard
- 17 exhibits starting off with the pooling application checklist
- 18 as Exhibit A, followed by a copy of the application as
- 19 Exhibit B, and next in the packet is the affidavit of Greq
- 20 Pazer who is the landman for Chevron in this case.
- 21 He has not previously testified before the
- 22 Division but Chevron seeks to admit him as an expert landman
- 23 and he provides a copy of his resume as Chevron Exhibit 1.
- 24 His affidavit explains that Chevron is seeking an order
- 25 pooling all interest in the Wolfcamp formation in a standard

- 1 640 acre horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2 of
- 2 Section 13 and 24. This is all in Township 26 South, Range
- 3 32 East in Lea County, New Mexico.
- 4 The initial wells in this spacing unit will be
- 5 the SD 24 13 Fed P, as in Paul, 415, and then these are the
- 6 17H through 19H wells, and it looks like the API numbers
- 7 have not yet been assigned, but the surface and bottom hole
- 8 locations are described in Mr. Pazer's affidavit, as well as
- 9 Chevron's Exhibit B-2 which are copies of the C-102s for
- 10 each of the wells.
- 11 This is a spacing unit which is a proximity tract
- 12 well to allow Chevron to create an enlarged spacing unit.
- 13 It has the 18H well within 330 feet of the E/2 E/2 of those
- 14 sections.
- The pool code for the wells is 98065. And
- 16 Chevron provides as its Exhibit C-3 and C-4 a tract and unit
- 17 recap as well as a list of the uncommitted interest owners
- 18 that Chevron is seeking to pool in this case.
- 19 Chevron sent each of the interest owners well
- 20 proposal letters and has made a good faith attempt to obtain
- 21 voluntary joinder in the wells. And Chevron will notify the
- 22 Division if there is any agreements that are reached before
- 23 the pooling order is entered.
- 24 Then Chevron's Exhibit D is the affidavit of
- 25 Alexandra Fleming. She is Chevron's geologist for this

1 project. Her affidavit is attached as Chevron's Exhibit D,

- 2 and she has not previously testified before the Division
- 3 either, so Chevron seeks to qualify her as an expert in
- 4 petroleum geology today.
- 5 Ms. Fleming attaches her resume as D-1. With
- 6 that, she explains in her affidavit that Chevron is
- 7 targeting the Wolfcamp formation with these wells and she
- 8 has included the standard exhibits starting off with a
- 9 project location map, as well as a gun barrel diagram as
- 10 shown on Exhibit D-2.
- 11 Following that map she has a fee structure map,
- 12 and her opinion is that this formation is appropriate for
- 13 horizontal well development. She also includes a cross
- 14 section map of a structural cross section for the Wolfcamp
- 15 formation that shows the target interval for the initial
- 16 wells.
- 17 Finally in the exhibit package I have included an
- 18 affidavit reflecting that my office provided notice of this
- 19 hearing to the interest owners to be pooled, and notice by
- 20 mail and notice by publication was provided just to be sure
- 21 that notice of the hearing was provided to all interest
- 22 owners.
- 23 So with that I would move the admission of
- 24 Chevron's A through F and tender Mr. Pazer and Ms. Flemming
- 25 as experts in their qualified fields and just request that

1 the Division take the case under advisement if there are no

- 2 questions.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Rose-Coss, any
- 4 questions?
- 5 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: No questions.
- 6 MS. LUCK: Thank you.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Luck, I'm just
- 8 looking at your notice here.
- 9 MS. LUCK: Okay.
- 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: You seem to have the
- 11 same problem Mr. Bruce had, which was publishing on November
- 12 18. And unlike your colleague Mr. Rankin, you have a lot
- 13 more people you have to notify here. I don't know if I'm
- 14 reading this exhibit from the postal service correctly, but
- 15 it does seem like some of them have yet to be delivered or
- 16 they are threatening to return them. So it seems like you
- 17 might need the newspaper notice in this case.
- 18 MS. LUCK: Right. Would it be possible for the
- 19 case to simply be continued to December 16 hearing to allow
- 20 the time to run and it brought back up at that time and be
- 21 taken under advisement if there is no questions?
- 22 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: It certainly is
- 23 possible.
- MS. LUCK: Thank you.
- 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So with that, I will
