- 2 with status conferences. The first items on the agenda --
- 3 and, as always, the worksheet for today is posted on our
- 4 website under the tab "final worksheet."
- 5 The first eight items all should be one
- 6 consolidated status conference, and I will call Case Numbers
- 7 21849, 21850, 22393, 22394, 22161, 22162, 22163 and 22164,
- 8 and we will start with Chisholm Energy.
- 9 MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiner,
- 10 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart
- on behalf of Chisholm Energy Operating.
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you, good
- 13 morning. Mewbourne Oil Company?
- MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce representing
- 15 Mewbourne.
- 16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you, good
- 17 morning, Mr. Bruce. All right, EOG Resources?
- 18 MR. RITTENHOUSE: This is Joby Rittenhouse
- 19 appearing on behalf of EOG.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Oxy USA Inc.?
- 21 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, that would be
- 22 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland &
- 23 Hart.
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Apache
- 25 Corporation?

1 MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Mr. Examiner, Deana

- 2 Bennett on behalf of Apache Corporation.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Now, further down I
- 4 have got some cases, COG Operating.
- 5 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr. Examiner.
- 6 Ocean Munds-Dry for COG Operating LLC.
- 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other
- 8 entries of appearances for Cases 21849, 50, 22393, 94,
- 9 22161, 62, 63, 64?
- 10 (No audible response.)
- 11 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, I guess
- 12 we will start with you, Mr. Feldewert.
- 13 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, these competing
- 14 cases involve Chisholm's -- this case involves Sections 7
- 15 and 18 in 19 South, 33 East. Chisholm seeks to develop its
- 16 acreage with two-mile stand-up wells. Mewbourne has
- 17 competing -- it seems like we have some interference. Can
- 18 you hear me okay?
- 19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: There is a little bit
- 20 of scratchiness, but --
- 21 REPORTER: It sounds like there's a copy machine
- 22 going in the background.
- 23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: That's exactly what
- 24 it sounds like. Go ahead, Mr. Feldewert.
- MR. FELDEWERT: So anyway, Mewbourne has

- 1 competing development plans. They seek to match up some
- 2 acreage they own with Section 18 where they do not have any
- 3 ownership. So that's what this case is all about. We had
- 4 intended to proceed to hearing today, but I believe it was
- 5 Apache's counsel that filed a motion that was unopposed by
- 6 the parties to vacate the prehearing order and continue the
- 7 matter so that they could conduct some additional analysis
- 8 of the competing proposed cases. So that's where we are.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So in your estimation
- 10 we are headed for a hearing at this point; correct?
- MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, Mr. Examiner, yes.
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Bruce, any
- 13 disagreement?
- MR. BRUCE: Nope.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So I will
- 16 then look to Ms. Bennett.
- 17 MS. BENNETT: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. Yes, Mr.
- 18 Feldewert's recitation of what happened here is accurate.
- 19 It's my understanding that Apache was only recently provided
- 20 notices of Mewbourne cases even though Apache owns an
- 21 interest in some of the acreage, and so Apache had reached
- 22 out -- well, we had reached out on Apache's behalf to
- 23 request a continuance of time for Apache to review the
- 24 proposal letters.
- 25 And so I think we are looking at a hearing, as

1 you mentioned, and it would be Apache's preference to have

- 2 the hearing in a, in a couple of months depending upon the
- 3 hearing examiner's schedule and OCD's schedule.
- 4 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Well, let
- 5 me go around the board here. Mr. Rittenhouse, any thoughts
- 6 on behalf of EOG?
- 7 MR. RITTENHOUSE: Nothing from EOG.
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Ms. Munds-Dry?
- 9 MS. MUNDS-DRY: No, sir, thank you.
- 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I guess, Mr.
- 11 Feldewert, I don't know if you had any separate thoughts on
- 12 that.
- MR. FELDEWERT: I do not.
- 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So, Mr.
- 15 Feldewert, Mr. Bruce, Apache is offering to have a hearing,
- 16 but a few months out, which is really all we have in terms
- of openings, anyway. So, concerns?
- 18 MR. BRUCE: No. I was told by Mewbourne, Mr.
- 19 Examiner, that whatever satisfied Apache was fine with them.
- MR. FELDEWERT: And, Mr. Examiner, I, when we
- 21 received the request, I alerted Chisholm to the -- or the
- 22 state of the Division's docket, and so they recognized and
- 23 they agreed to the continuance that it may be, it may be set
- 24 in April, last time we spoke, April or May before we would
- 25 have a hearing, so we understand the position of the

- 1 Division.
- 2 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Well, that was last
- 3 month. This month Marlene warns me May 19 is our next open
- 4 docket.
- 5 MR. BRUCE: That's fine with me, Mr. Examiner.
- 6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you, Mr. Bruce.
- 7 MR. FELDEWERT: We will make that work, Mr.
- 8 Examiner.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Apache?
- 10 MS. BENNETT: Thank you very much, Mr. Examiner.
- 11 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Any other concerns,
- 12 any other interested parties in Cases 21849, 21850, 22393,
- 13 294, 22161, 62, 63, 64?
- 14 (No audible response.)
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, those
- 16 cases will be scheduled for a contested hearing on May 19.
- 17 We will draft a prehearing order or an amended prehearing
- 18 order and get it out to the parties. As always, please file
- 19 continuances.
- MS. BENNETT: Mr. Examiner, one question about
- 21 that, Apache filed a motion for a continuance already, and
- 22 those were filed on January 25, but they don't appear in the
- 23 OCD file. Sorry about that.
