- 9 green. I am wearing my tie from Dublin.
- 10 MS. RYAN: All right.
- 11 Yes, sir. I wanted to just note, for you
- 12 and the rest of the people on the call, Joby Rittenhouse
- 13 has joined ConocoPhillips and he will be appearing for
- 14 ConocoPhillips and the Concho entities on occasion in the
- 15 future, so I just wanted to bring him to your attention.
