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1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: We will go to Items 7

- 2 through 13? Yes. The Cases 22093, 22349, 22112, 22184,
- 3 22171, 22172 and 22408. Let's start off with Mewbourne Oil
- 4 Company.
- 5 MR. FELDEWERT: Good morning, Mr. Examiner.
- 6 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland &
- 7 Hart.
- 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Ascent
- 9 Energy?
- 10 MR. SAVAGE: Good morning, Darin Savage for
- 11 Ascent Energy.
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Alpha Energy
- 13 Partners.
- MS. HARDY: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Dana
- 15 Hardy with the Santa Fe office of Hinkle Shanor on behalf of
- 16 Alpha Energy Partners.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: We have a few other
- 18 parties involved here. Let's see, Matador Production
- 19 Company?
- 20 (No audible response.)
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: By the look on your
- 22 face, Mr. Feldewert, it is falling apart.
- MR. FELDEWERT: I wasn't aware because I wasn't
- 24 conscious of the fact that we did enter an appearance for
- 25 Matador.

1 MR. SAVAGE: Mr. Hearing Examiner, so Matador

- 2 received the interest of Ascent in these units, and they are
- 3 working out -- trying to work out some kind of a resolution.
- 4 Matador is in this -- I'm in the other -- in both cases, I
- 5 made an appearance on behalf of Matador, but Holland & Hart
- 6 hasn't had an entry of appearance for Matador, so I'm still
- 7 maintaining Ascent. But those interests that Ascent has,
- 8 those are Matador's interests, just to clarify on that, but,
- 9 you know.
- 10 So I didn't know how to handle that, I e-mailed
- 11 Holland & Hart on that, and but that's how it stands now,
- 12 just the point of confusion about how we got to this point.
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. At some point
- 14 when you reach a conclusion, if you could put something into
- 15 the record that would be appreciated.
- MR. FELDEWERT: Will do.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. I think I
- 18 have MRC Permian?
- 19 MR. FELDEWERT: That would be Matador.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. City of
- 21 Carlsbad?
- 22 MS. BENNETT: Good morning. Deana Bennett,
- 23 Modrall Sperling on behalf of the City of Carlsbad.
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And Oil
- 25 Conservation Division here today? Mr. Tremaine?

- 1 (No audible response.)
- 2 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And I also have
- 3 Realeza del Spear in one of the cases.
- 4 MR. MORGAN: Scott Morgan with Cavin & Ingram for
- 5 Realeza del Spear.
- 6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Any other interested
- 7 persons in Cases 22093, 22349, 112, 184, 171, 172 and 22408?
- 8 (No audible response.)
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think these are
- 10 contested cases in the Carlsbad area overlapping
- 11 applications. I guess I will throw it to you, Mr. Savage,
- 12 can you can start us off?
- 13 MR. SAVAGE: Yes, thank you. They are, they are
- 14 the overlapping cases, and they have been put on, on some
- 15 delay because of certain remediation of other wells adjacent
- 16 in that area. And then now, we had transition from Ascent
- 17 Energy to Matador, which throws another bit of a wrench into
- 18 the matter.
- 19 Matador's interested in a -- a second status
- 20 conference. They have been working with the parties and
- 21 talking with the parties in the same way they have been with
- 22 the same Anvil cases. And in those cases, the Division was
- 23 kind enough to grant a second status conference.
- 24 This involves the same kinds of issues, the
- 25 conversations, negotiations can be productive, and on behalf

1 of Ascent and Matador, based on discussions we have had with

- 2 Holland & Hart on this, we would request a second status
- 3 conference and see how this progresses to see if we can
- 4 reach a resolution in the matter.
- 5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Ms. Hardy?
- 6 MS. HARDY: Thank you. Alpha Energy Partners is
- 7 talking with the other parties. I think they would like to
- 8 have a hearing set for these matters given the hearings are
- 9 being set several months out, I think they are concerned
- 10 about the delay that would result from another status
- 11 conference and if a resolution isn't reached then a
- 12 contested hearing date two or three months after that. So
- 13 they would like to have this matter resolved.
- 14 It's my understanding the Brine Well remediation
- 15 that was at issue is almost complete, and so Alpha would
- 16 prefer to set a contested hearing date in, I would suggest
- 17 May, and then if the parties are still talking and need more
- 18 time at that point we could seek a continuance or another
- 19 status conference.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr.
- 21 Feldewert?
- 22 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Brancard, as you know we
- 23 filed a motion to vacate the hearing that was scheduled for
- 24 today so that we could have a status conference. I have
- 25 been in touch with Mewbourne. They, they agree there are

1 productive discussions occurring, but they wanted to set

- 2 this for another status conference, but their suggestion was
- 3 a month, but no longer than that for another status
- 4 conference to keep things moving.
- 5 So kind of leave it up to you, if you want to
- 6 have a status conference in a month or set a hearing in May,
- 7 I think either of those actions would keep things moving
- 8 here towards a resolution.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. I will
- 10 just check with Ms. Bennett?
- MS. BENNETT: The City of Carlsbad is just
- 12 waiting to see how this all shakes out, so no position on
- 13 any of these discussions today.
- 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Well City of
- 15 Carlsbad shouldn't be doing any shaking of the Brine Well.
- MS. BENNETT: That's right.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Morgan?
- 18 MR. MORGAN: Mr. Examiner, my clients are
- 19 comfortable with setting for a hearing or another status
- 20 conference. We checked with our clients for all dates of
- 21 their non-availability through the end of June, and there
- 22 was only two dates, May 19 and June 16 they wouldn't be
- 23 available. Other than that they would be available for a
- 24 contested hearing.
- 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: You are not available

- 1 May 19.
- MR. MORGAN: May 19 my clients are not available.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. I'm going
- 4 to throw out this idea and you all can react to it. I'm
- 5 going to set this for a contested hearing on June 2.
- 6 Reactions? Ms. Hardy?
- 7 MS. HARDY: That would be fine with Alpha, Mr.
- 8 Examiner.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Savage? And I
- 10 know it wasn't what you wanted, but -- you are on mute, I
- 11 believe.
- 12 MR. SAVAGE: That sounds like a fair compromise,
- 13 you know, as long as we are moving forward with negotiations
- 14 we have some time to do that. And if the Division is
- 15 willing to consider a continuance or another status
- 16 conference depending on how things work out, that would be
- 17 great.
- 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Feldewert?
- 19 MR. FELDEWERT: My only concern is whether that
- 20 keeps discussions moving forward knowing how people work.
- 21 But, Mr. Examiner, if you think that's the appropriate
- 22 thing, Mewbourne does not object to that. They are all
- 23 (inaudible) to keep things moving forward.
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I appreciate that.
- 25 And I think that hopefully in the short while, I'm not privy

Page 10 to this, but I assume there will be a little more clarity about the conditions that the Division expects around the 2 Brine Well. 3 The Division should be getting a report from its 5 contractors soon about, what does it all look and feel like now that they are pumping sand into the ground, are there 6 any recommendations from the contractor about future work. 7 So hopefully that will clarify things for 8 9 everybody and you all can work with the Division on that if other conditions are needed. All right. 10 So Cases 22093, 349, 22112, 184, 171, 172 and 11 22408 will be set for a contested hearing on June 2, and if 12 13 I need to issue an order I will.
