- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. With that I'm
- 3 going to call Items 16 through 23, which were consolidated
- 4 at our previous hearing. These are Cases 22359, 22360,
- 5 22361, 22362, 22509, 22510, 22511, 22512.
- 6 Let's start with Ascent Energy/Matador
- 7 Production Company.
- 8 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce on behalf of
- 9 both companies.
- 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 11 ConocoPhillips. No one here today for
- 12 ConocoPhillips?
- 13 Ms. Ryan, if you are trying to speak,
- 14 you're muted.
- 15 MS. RYAN: Thank you. Sorry. I was having
- 16 trouble getting back on.
- So, yes, I'm entering an appearance today
- 18 for ConocoPhillips.
- 19 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Do you have any
- 20 objections to these cases going ahead, then?
- MS. RYAN: We don't. None.
- 22 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right, Mr. Bruce.
- 23 Any other interested person, then? Let me
- 24 just check on Cases 22359, -360, -361, -362, 22509, -510,
- 25 -511, -512.

1 Hearing none, Mr. Bruce you may proceed.

- MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, collectively all of
- 3 these cases cover the west half of Section 16 and the west
- 4 half of Section 21 in 20 South, 33 East in Lea County.
- 5 The Ascent cases -- I'll just refer to them
- 6 by their docket number -- not the docket number but case
- 7 number. 16, the Ascent case goes with Case 20, the
- 8 Matador case, and so on down the line. 17 goes with 21,
- 9 18 goes with 22, and 19 goes with 23.
- 10 I did file a motion to consolidate. I've
- 11 submitted affidavits to you on each case. The affidavits
- 12 are virtually identical, so I'll just go through the first
- 13 exhibit package.
- 14 This one is -- and in the lands covered,
- 15 there were requests for both the Bone Spring and Wolfcamp
- 16 Formation wells. In these cases Ascent obtained Orders
- 17 pooling the acreage. They were dated November 13, 2021.
- 18 After the Pooling Orders were issued the
- 19 Applicant filed APDs with the BLM, which took a darn long
- 20 time to issue, so by the time that Ascent was looking at
- 21 drilling, they had to get an extension, they just couldn't
- 22 get all the equipment up and going, so we filed the
- 23 applications a day before the expiration deadline.
- 24 In the interim while these matters were set
- 25 for the early January hearing, Matador acquired Ascent's

1 interest in these wells, and I recommended to the client

- 2 that I didn't see any way around it but we had to apply on
- 3 Matador's behalf, and asked that we relate back the filing
- 4 date to those in the Ascent applications, because of
- 5 course under the Division's filing scheme Matador's
- 6 applications were new applications. And obviously the
- 7 turnover of operations slowed things down. There was some
- 8 related cases on the Silver (phonetic) wells just to the
- 9 north, immediately to the north of these cases where
- 10 extensions were granted.
- 11 Exhibits 2 and 3 are the Matador and Ascent
- 12 applications.
- 13 Exhibit 4 is the landman's affidavit. And
- 14 he discusses the reasons why Ascent could not commence the
- 15 wells in time, and then Matador on behalf of MRC Permian
- 16 Company took over operations and slowed things down so it
- 17 would ask that based on the consolidated applications
- 18 Matador be granted until November 13th of this year to
- 19 commence the wells.
- 20 The Affidavit of Notice I submitted. I
- 21 will be filing a Supplemental Notice. When I filed the
- 22 exhibits on Tuesday night/Wednesday morning, I could not
- 23 track down the green cards so I had to attach the Postal
- 24 Service online notices showing that all the mail had been
- 25 delivered. Late yesterday, after rummaging around a lot

1 of paperwork, I came across the actual green cards. I

- 2 have all of the green cards for all of the parties
- 3 notified, and so late yesterday I prepared supplemental
- 4 Notice exhibits for each of the cases, and I need to
- 5 attach a Notice of Filing explaining what happened.
- 6 But all parties did receive actual
- 7 Certified Notice of the applications, so Notice is
- 8 correct.
- 9 And again we request that these exhibit
- 10 packages for the eight cases be admitted into the record
- 11 and the cases are taken under advisement.
- 12 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 13 Ms. Ryan, any questions for Conoco?
- MS. RYAN: None. Thank you.
- 15 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Lowe, questions.
- 16 EXAMINER LOWE: I have no questions. Thank you.
- 17 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So Mr. Bruce
- 18 you're going to submit -- you indicated you will submit
- 19 the green cards?
- 20 MR. BRUCE: Yeah, I'll submit a new Exhibit 5
- 21 for each case which will include copies of the Certified
- 22 green cards.
- 23 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So let me just
- 24 ask once again: Are there any other interested parties
- 25 for Cases 22359, -360, -361, -362, 22509, -510, -511, 512?

Page 8 Hearing none, these cases will be taken under advisement. We will leave the record open for the submittal of the additional Notice information, specifically the green cards. Thank you. (Time noted 8:47 a.m.)
