- 4 22084. Let's start with Matador Production Company.
- 5 MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiner,
- 6 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland &
- 7 Hart.
- 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: We have E.G.L. Resources,
- 9 which has apparently been succeeded by Chisholm Energy.
- 10 MR. PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, this is Ernest L.
- 11 Padilla for Chisholm Energy, but that is going to change.
- 12 We're trying to file a succession parties yesterday, and we
- 13 don't have permission yet to file anything on behalf of
- 14 Earthstone Operating, who will take over these applications
- 15 that originally were filed by E.G.L.
- 16 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So E.G.L.
- 17 transfers to Chisholm, who's now transferring to Earthstone.
- 18 MR. PADILLA: Correct.
- 19 EXAMINER BRANCARD: And will you remain in as
- 20 counsel, Mr. Padilla?
- MR. PADILLA: Yes.
- 22 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So I have an entry from
- 23 EOG Resources.
- MR. PARROT: Morning this is James Parrot with
- 25 Beatty & Wozniak, representing EOG Resources, Inc.

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1 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Parrot, you're a little

- 2 muffled there, so --
- 3 MR. PARROT: I will speak up. Is that a little
- 4 better?
- 5 EXAMINER BRANCARD: It's a little better, thank
- 6 you. And then, let me see, I have Cimarex Energy Company.
- 7 MR. SAVAGE: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Darin
- 8 Savage, with Abadie & Schill, for Cimarex Energy Company.
- 9 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. And I think I have XTO
- 10 Energy.
- 11 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, Mr. Examiner, Michael
- 12 Feldewert with Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart.
- 13 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Any other interested
- 14 parties in these cases? It's 21683, -685, 22103, -104,
- 15 -083, -084. Hearing none.
- 16 So once upon a time, we had a prehearing order; it got
- 17 vacated, and since then, we've had numerous status
- 18 conferences, so where are we? I'll start with you,
- 19 Mr. Feldewert.
- MR. FELDEWERT: Well, what I -- as you can
- 21 imagine, with the changes in the applicant for the competing
- 22 pooling cases, that has prompted a series of discussions.
- 23 It's my understanding that the parties are still in what
- 24 they consider to be productive discussions, so I've been
- 25 instructed to -- on behalf of MRC Permian, to seek a status

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1 conference in two months to allow the -- all the parties now

- 2 that are involved time to have -- move their discussions
- 3 along and see where we are.
- 4 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 5 Mr. Padilla.
- 6 MR. PADILLA: Mr. Examiner, I agree with what
- 7 Michael has indicated. The parties are indeed negotiating,
- 8 so I think a status conference would be appropriate, or if
- 9 the examiner wishes, to set this matter for hearing, then it
- 10 should be, probably, in July at least, to give more time,
- 11 but I -- we're not opposed to a status conference.
- 12 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Let me just go around
- 13 the horn here quickly.
- 14 Mr. Parrot, any position, EOG?
- MR. PARROT: No objection to either of those
- 16 plans.
- 17 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 18 Mr. Savage, for Cimarex?
- 19 MR. SAVAGE: No objection.
- 20 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And I assume
- 21 Mr. Feldewert, you're okay with yourself?
- 22 MR. FELDEWERT: Last time I checked, yes.
- 23 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So why don't we
- 24 set this, then, for a status conference on July 7th. Thank
- 25 you.
